

**SENTENCING FOR  
THE WEEK OF 7/12/2010**

DEFENDANT: Rene Oswaldo Marquez

CITY/RESIDENCE: West Saint Paul, MN  
AGENCY: Woodbury Police Department  
CONVICTION: I: First Degree DWI  
SENTENCE: The defendant was committed to the Commissioner of Corrections for 48 months. Execution of sentence was stayed and the defendant was placed on probation for 7 years with the following conditions: 1) serve 180 days with credit for 294; 2) he is to do 30 days annually on the alcohol monitor; 3) complete a chemical dependency evaluation and follow the recommendations; 4) no use and random testing; 5) remain law abiding; 6) no possession or use of any sort of non-prescribed drugs or alcohol; 7) provide a DNA sample; 8) pay a \$200; 9) also subject to the 5 year mandatory conditional release.

SENTENCE: Court stayed adjudication of sentence and placed the defendant on probation for 3 years on the following conditions: 1) Complete Book-In Motion immediately following sentencing. 2) Abstain from the use or possession of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol and marijuana and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at his own expense, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 3) Complete outpatient chemical dependency treatment in accordance with the chemical dependency evaluation dated 5/28/2010, and follow all aftercare recommendations, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 4) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. 5) Cooperate with the transfer of his supervision to his county/state of residence, if eligible. Court imposed a \$50 fine plus fees.

Time may be served by completing 120 hours of Community Work Service within 6 months, 15 days out-of-custody Sentence to Service, and the remainder (132 days) on Electronic Home Monitoring, criteria waived. 2) Abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis and/or breathalyzers at his own expense, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 3) Complete all mental health programming, including taking all prescribed medication at the direction of the mental health professional, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 4) Comply with all requirements of Washington County Community Services, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 5) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. 6) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis. Court also imposed a \$50 fine plus fees.
