

**SENTENCING FOR
THE WEEK OF 7/6/2009**

DATE: 7/8/2009

DEFENDANT: Colin Emmet Orcutt

DOB: 4/29/1988

CITY/RESIDENCE: BAYPORT, MN

AGENCY: Oak Park Heights Police Department

CONVICTION: Terroristic Threats

SENTENCE: (1) Supervised probation for up to five years; (2) serve 90 days in jail, with credit for four days served; defendant may serve the jail time on in-custody Sentence to Service or work release, and criteria were waived; (3) pay a \$250 fine and surcharges on a schedule to be determined by Court Administration; (4) have no direct or indirect contact with victims; (5) complete a full group treatment program for aggression, and follow all recommendations, including aftercare; (6) complete a medical evaluation and take all prescribed medications at the direction of mental health professionals; (7) obtain a chemical dependency evaluation and follow all recommendations, including aftercare; (8) abstain from the use of mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalyses at his own expense; defendant must submit a baseline urinalysis today; (9) defendant to remain law abiding and cooperate with probation; (10) defendant to submit a biological specimen for DNA analysis.

CONVICTION: Drugs - 5th Degree

SENTENCE: The court committed the defendant to the Commissioner of Corrections for 13 months and stayed the execution of sentence and placed the defendant on probation for 10 years under the following conditions. 1) Serve 180 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 67 days served. (2) Pay a fine of \$50 plus surcharges on a schedule to be established by court administration. 3) Complete all mental health programming including taking all prescribed medication at the direction of the mental health professional. 4) Complete out-patient chemical dependency treatment unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 5) Abstain from the use of all mood altering chemicals including alcohol and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at her own expense unless the supervising probation officer deems testing unnecessary. Submit baseline urinalysis today. 6) Attend AA/NA meeting as recommended by the treatment program for a minimum of two times per week for 12 months and provide verification to the supervising probation officer. 7) Obtain a GED and/or seek and maintain gainful employment and provide verification to the supervising probation officer. 8) Have no same or similar offenses. Be law abiding and cooperate with all of the standard conditions of probation. 9) Cooperate with the transfer of her supervision to her county of residence. 10) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis

SENTENCE: The court committed defendant to the Commissioner of Corrections for 25 months concurrent to Ramsey County Case (62-CR-09-1989). Defendant ordered to pay \$50 fine plus surcharges and restitution to Chase Bank in the amount of \$427.72 to be taken from prison wages.

SENTENCE: The court committed defendant to the Commissioner of Corrections for a period of 50 months with credit for 174 days. In addition, defendant is ordered to pay a fine of \$50 plus surcharges to be deducted from future earnings at a MN Correctional Facility; pay restitution of \$2430.39 to the Crime Victims Reparations Board to be paid from future earnings at a MN Correctional Facility; pay restitution of \$2630 to victim to be paid from future earnings at a MN Correctional Facility; provide biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis.

SENTENCE: Stay of imposition and probation for five years on the following conditions: (1) complete chemical dependency programming and follow all recommendations, including aftercare; (2) complete counseling that the defendant is currently enrolled in; (3) participate in a domestic abuse treatment program, if recommended by probation; (4) abstain from chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random testing; (5) provide a DNA sample; (6) have no same or similar offenses, (7) remain law abiding; (8) 15 days in jail, with credit for five days served; can be done on out-of-custody Sentence to Service, and (9) pay a \$200 fine.
