DEFENDANT: Renee McCaster

AGENCY: Washington County Sheriff's Office

CONVICTION: Theft - by check

SENTENCE: Court committed defendant to Commissioner of Corrections for 13 months with execution of sentence stayed and defendant placed on probation for 5 years on the following conditions: 1) Pay a fine of \$50. 2) Defendant to serve 95 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 95 days served. 3) Pay restitution in the amount of \$2,315.08 to Lampert's Yard, Inc through Washington County Court Administration on a schedule to be established by the supervising probation officer. 4) Abstain from the use of all mood altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at her own expense, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 5) Seek and maintain gainful employment and provide verification to the supervising probation officer. 6) No same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all of the standard conditions of probation. 7) Cooperate with the transfer of her supervision to her county of residence. 8) Provide a biological specimen for purposed of DNA analysis.

SENTENCE: (1) Supervised probation for up to five years; (2) serve 30 days in the Washington County Jail, with credit for 22 days served; (3) abstain from mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalyses at her own expense; (4) complete a chemical dependency evaluation within 30 days and follow all recommendations; (5) complete a psychological evaluation within 30 days and follow all recommendations; (6) complete a Cognitive Skills Programming evaluation in her county of residence, and follow all recommendations; (7) seek and maintain gainful employment and provide verification to the supervising probation agent; (8) have no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding, and cooperate with probation; (9) cooperate with the transfer of her probation to her county of residence, and (10) pay a \$50 fine.

SENTENCE: Court stayed imposition of sentence and placed Defendant on probation for 5 years on the following conditions: 1) \$50 fine plus fees/surcharges. 2) Serve 198 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 198 days served. 3) Abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at her own expense, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 4) Obtain an updated chemical dependency evaluation w/in 30 days and follow all recommendations, including aftercare, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 5) Seek and maintain gainful employment and/or education and provide verification to the supervising probation officer. 6) No same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. 7) Cooperate with the transfer of her supervision to her county of residence. 8) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis.

SENTENCE: (1) Supervised probation for up to five years; (2) serve 95 days in the Washington County Jail, with credit for 65 days served; (3) pay a \$50 fine and surcharges on a schedule to be determined by Court Administration; (4) pay \$1,000 in restitution to the victim through Washington County Court Administration on a schedule to be determined by the supervising probation agent; (5) defendant to be evaluated for the Washington County Intensive Probation Supervision, and to comply with that program, if appropriate; (6) have no direct or indirect contact with the victim or his residence; (7) complete all mental health programming, including taking prescribed medications at the direction of a mental health professional; (8) complete the in-patient chemical dependency treatment at the Anoka Care Facility and comply with all recommendations; (9) abstain from the use of mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalyses at his own expense, and defendant must submit a urinalysis today; (10) seek and maintain gainful employment and provide verification to the supervising probation agent; (11) have no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding, and cooperate with probation, and (12) defendant to possess no firearms during the period of his probation.

SENTENCE: Imposition of sentence stayed and placed on probation for 2 years under the following conditions: 1) serve 20 days in the Washington County jail with credit for 4 days served, time may be served on in or out-of-custody Sentence to Service, Huber, or straight time;

2) have no direct or indirect contact with the victims and their residence; 3) Complete an evaluation for cognitive skills programming if available in the county of residence and follow all recommendations; 4) ordered to pursue high school diploma or GED and provide verification to the supervising probation officer; 5) have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation; 6) cooperate with the transfer of supervision to county of residence; 7) pay \$50 fine plus surcharges. A biological specimen for DNA analysis has previously been submitted.

SENTENCE: 13 months, stay of execution, 5 years probation on the following: 1) Defendant to serve 87 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 50 days served; time to be served is recommended on work release, in-custody Sentence to Service or out-of-custody Sentence to Service if qualified, criteria waived; 2) Pay restitution in the amount of \$1,641.44 to Target Corporation through Washington County Court Administration on a schedule to be established by the supervising probation officer; to be deducted from prison wages; 3) Have no direct or indirect contact with any Target Stores; 4) Provide proof and authorization of Department of Corrections psychological evaluation; 5) Seek and maintain gainful employment and provide verification to the supervising probation officer; 6) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation; 7) Cooperate with the transfer of his supervision to his county/state of residence; and 8) \$50 fine, surcharges waived.

SENTENCE: Imposition of sentence is stayed and placed on probation for a period of up to 15 years. A ten year conditional release period will apply if the sentence is ever executed and he is committed to the Commissioner of Corrections. The court placed the defendant on probation under the following conditions: 1) serve 135 days in the Washington County jail with credit for 113 days served; 2) restitution ordered; 3) have no direct or indirect contact with victim; 4) follow all standard conditions of the Washington County Community Corrections Sex Offender Unit unless the supervising agent deems it unnecessary; 5) follow all recommendations from the psycho-sexual evaluation including successfully completing sex offender treatment and aftercare, the treatment provider is to be approved by the supervising agent; 6) submit to polygraph testing by the supervising probation agent or a therapist; 7) abstain from the use of all mood altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random testing at own expense; 8) have no contact with minor females, except his younger sister until approved by supervising agent and the sex

offender program therapist. He may have contact with his younger sister; 9) no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation; 10) register as a predatory offender; 11) provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis; 12) pay \$50 fine plus surcharges and fees.

SENTENCE: Fleeing a Peace Officer in a Motor Vehicle: (1) supervised probation for up to three years; (2) serve 120 days in jail, with credit for 56 days served; (3) follow the conditions of the Intensive Probation Supervision Unit, if he resides in Ramsey County upon his release; (4) abstain from the use of mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalyses at his own expense; (5) complete the in-jail chemical dependency treatment program and any aftercare; (6) seek and maintain gainful employment and/or education and provide verification to the supervising probation agent; (7) have no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding, and cooperate with probation; (8) provide a biological specimen for DNA analysis, and (9) pay a \$50 fine and surcharges.

Third Degree DUI: 365 days in jail, and a \$3,000 fine, with 245 days and \$3,000 suspended for three years on the following conditions: (1) serve 90 days in jail, concurrent with the sentence in Count 1; (2) abstain from the use of mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, (3) follow all the standard conditions of the Intensive Probation Supervision Program; (4) complete the in-jail treatment program and follow all recommendations; (5) seek and maintain gainful employment; (6) have no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding, and cooperate with probation.
