Any program to be pre-approved by Washington County Community Corrections; 7) Complete all mental health programming/including taking all prescribed medication at the direction of the mental health professional, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary; 8) Follow all the standard conditions of the Sex Offender Unit, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary; 9) Make efforts to obtain his GED, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary; 10) Participate in the St. Paul Work Force Center Offender's Employment Program, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary; 11) Abstain from the use of all mood altering chemicals, including alcohol and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at his own expense, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary; 12) Submit to polygraph testing as directed by his supervising

probation officer or treatment provider; 13) Have no use or possession of a computer unless approved by his supervising probation officer and a therapist trained in the treatment of sexual offenders; 14) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all standard conditions of probation; 15) Cooperate with the transfer of his supervision to his County/State of residence; 16) Pursuant to §243.166, defendant be ordered to register as a predatory offender; and 17) Pursuant to §609.117, defendant be ordered to provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis.
