DEFENDANT: Jennifer Ann McMahon

CONVICTION: Controlled Substance Crime in the Fifth Degree

SENTENCE: (1) Submit to supervised probation for up to five years upon completion of her WI prison sentence; (2) pay a \$50 fine (surcharges and law library fee were waived, and (3) provide a biological specimen for DNA analysis.

Execution of sentence stayed and placed on probation for 15 years on the following conditions: 1) serve 70 days in jail with credit for 70 days served, to be served on the in-custody Sentence to Service if qualified/criteria waived; 2) pay \$50 fine plus surcharges; 3) complete an evaluation for Cognitive Skills Programming and follow all recommendations; 4) complete New Choices Program for chemical dependency treatment; 5) abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random testing at own expense; 6) seek and maintain gainful employment and provide verification; no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation; 8) provide a biological specimen for

purposes of DNA analysis; 9) complete a (RUDI) Resources for the Unemployed and Determined Individual Program; 10) follow all the standard conditions of the Intensive Supervision Unit.

Execution of sentence was stayed and the defendant was placed on probation for five years with the following conditions: 1) 77 days jail with credit for 77 days served; 2) \$1,000 fine plus surcharge; 3) follow all recommendations of a psychological evaluation as directed by the supervising probation agent; 4) follow the recommendations of a chemical health assessment; 5) follow the recommendations of anger management programming; 6) at this point, no contact, direct or in-direct, with the victim; 7) no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding; 8) abstain from the use of chemicals, including alcohol, submit to random testing; 9) cooperate with the transfer of probation to county of residence; 10) provide a DNA sample.

SENTENCE: The defendant was committed to the Commissioner of Corrections for a period of 1 year and 1 day under a stay of execution and placed on probation for a period of 5 years subject to the following conditions: credit for 111 days served, pay a \$50 fine, have no contact with victim, obtain an updated psychiatric evaluation and follow all recommendations, complete mental health programming, abstain from all mood altering chemicals including alcohol, be subject to random testing, seek and maintain gainful employment and remain law abiding.

SENTENCE: The court committed the defendant to the Commissioner of Corrections for 19 months and stayed the execution of the sentence and placed the defendant on probation for a period of 5 years under the following conditions. 1) Serve 180 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 28 days served. The time may be served on in-custody Sentence to Service and the court waived criteria. 2) Pay a fine of \$50 plus surcharges on a schedule to be established by court administration. 3) Pay restitution in the amount of \$1,795.94 to the victim through Washington County court administration on a schedule to be established by the supervising probation officer. 4) Abstain from the use of all mood altering chemicals including alcohol and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at his own expense. 5) Seek and maintain gainful

employment or education and provide verification to the supervising probation officer. 6) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all of the standard conditions of probation. 7) Cooperate with the transfer of his supervision to his county of residence. The defendant has previously submitted a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis.
