SENTENCE: The Defendant was committed to the Commissioner of Corrections for a period of 13 months. Stay of execution of sentence and placed on probation for a period of 5 years:84 days in the Washington County jail; pay fine in amount of \$50 plus surcharges on a schedule; pay restitution in amount of \$650 to Gentry Place Apartments; complete Victim/Offender Conferencing; complete an anger management evaluation and follow all recommendations; seek & maintain gainful employment & provide verification; have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, & cooperate with all the standard conditions; provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis.

Count II: The defendant was given a \$3,000 fine and 365 days in jail. \$2,950 of the fine and 275 days of jail were suspended for three years with the following conditions: 1) 3 years probation, concurrent with Count I; 2) 90 days jail, the same as Count I; 3) \$50 fine plus surcharge; 4) restitution is left open for 30 days; 5) complete a cognitive skills evaluation and follow the recommendations; 6) complete all mental health programming; 7) complete chemical dependency evaluation and follow the recommendations; 8) abstain from chemicals, including alcohol; 9) complete the Repeat Offender DUI Program; 10) no same or similar offenses and remain law abiding; 11) cooperate with the transfer of probation.
