DATE: 8/6/2008

DEFENDANT: Christine Lynne Trubiano

DOB: 9/1/1965

CITY/RESIDENCE: Woodbury, MN

AGENCY: Washington County Sheriff's Office

CONVICTION: Public Nuisance

SENTENCE: The defendant was given 90 days jail and a \$1,000 fine. 90 days of the jail and \$700 of the fine were suspended for 1 year on the following conditions: 1) pay remainder of fine plus surcharges; 2) have no driver license violations; 3) no same or similar offenses and remain law abiding.

CONVICTION: Controlled Substance Crime in the 5th Degree

SENTENCE: The defendant was given a stay of adjudication of sentence and was placed on probation for three years with the following conditions: 1) 5 days jail with credit for 5 days; 2) \$500 fine plus surcharge; 3) attend 12 Step or AA program meetings for 3 months and provide verification; 4) abstain from the use of mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random testing, unless the probation agent deems it unnecessary; 5) no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding; 6) cooperate with the transfer of probation to county of residence.

SENTENCE: Committed to the Commissioner of Corrections for 12 months and 1 day. Court stays the execution of sentence and placed defendant on probation for 5 years under the following conditions: 1) Serve 180 days in jail with credit for 10 days served. 2) Pay \$500 fine plus surcharges, taken from bail. 3) Complete a chemical dependency evaluation and follow all recommendations, including aftercare plans. 4) Abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at own expense. 5) Maintain gainful employment and provide verification. 6) Follow all standard conditions of the Intensive Supervision Unit. 7) No same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. 8) Cooperate with the transfer of his supervision to his County/State of residence. 9) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis.

of DNA analysis. 5) No same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. 6) Chemical Dependency evaluation and follow all recommendations.
