

**SENTENCING FOR

DEFENDANT: Jonathan James Mattson

CONVICTION: 1st Degree Property Damage

SENTENCE: Probation for 5 years on the following conditions: 1) serve 30 days in jail with credit for 2 days served, to be served on Work Release or in or out-of-custody Sentence to Service; 2) pay \$50 fine plus surcharges; 3) restitution ordered; 4) abstain from the use of all mood altering chemicals excluding alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis at own expense; 5) complete a chemical dependency evaluation and follow all recommendations; 6) seek and maintain gainful employment and provide verification; 7) no same or similar offense, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation; 8) cooperate with the transfer of his supervision to his county of residence; 9) provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA Analysis.

SENTENCE: On Count I the court stayed the imposition of sentence and placed the defendant on probation for a period of 10 years under the following conditions: 1) Serve 180 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 4 days served. The time may be served on in-custody Sentence to Service with criteria waived. 2) Pay a fine of \$50 plus surcharges. 3) Pay restitution in the amount of \$400 to the victims through Washington County Court Administration. 4) Complete a chemical dependency evaluation and follow all recommendations including aftercare plans unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 5) Abstain from the use of all mood altering chemicals including alcohol and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at his own expense unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 6) Seek and maintain gainful employment and/or education and provide verification to the supervising probation officer. 7) Obtain his GED or high school diploma and provide verification to the supervising probation officer. 8) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all of the standard conditions of probation. 9) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis. On Count III, the court stayed the imposition of sentence and placed the defendant on probation for a period of 10 years under the same conditions as Count I except for the following substitution: Pay restitution in the amount of \$152 to the victim through Washington County Court Administration on a schedule to be established by the supervising probation officer. These are concurrent sentences.
