

**SENTENCING FOR
THE WEEK OF 8/18/2008**

DATE: 8/14/2008
DEFENDANT: Ryan Adam Bibeau
DOB: 5/20/1988
CITY/RESIDENCE: Mahtomedi, MN
AGENCY: Washington County Sheriff's Office
CONVICTION: 5th Degree Assault - Misdemeanor
SENTENCE: \$1,000 fine with \$300 stayed and 90 days of jail with 75 days stayed. The defendant was placed on probation for 2 years under the following conditions: (1) Serve 15 days in the Washington County jail with credit for 1 day served. The time may be served on out-of-custody Sentence to Service (STS) in Washington County or in the county where the defendant is attending school or in lieu of STS, the defendant may contact probation and do 120 hours of Community Work Service if he is not able to work out the STS plan. The defendant has 6 months to complete the jail time, STS, or Community Work Service. (2) Pay a fine of \$700 plus surcharges on a schedule to be established by Court Administration. (3) Participate in individual therapy focusing on critical thinking/judgment and anger management issues unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. (4) Abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol and submit to random urinalysis/breathalizers at his own expense. Baseline urinalysis to be submitted at time of sentencing. (5) Have no same/similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with the standard conditions of probation. (6) Register as a predatory offender pursuant to Minn. Stat. 243.166.

SENTENCE: 15 months, stay of execution, 5 years probation on the following: 1) Serve 90 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for one day served. Time to be served straight time - report in two weeks; 2) Pay a fine in the amount of \$500 plus surcharges on a schedule to be established by Court Administration; 3) Defendant have no use of computers or access to the internet unless or until deemed appropriate by a probation officer and therapist trained in the treatment and assessment of sexual offenders; 4) Actively participate in and successfully complete sex offender specific treatment at a program re-approved by Washington County Department of Community Corrections and follow all recommendations for programming and aftercare; 5) Abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at his own expense; take medications as prescribed; 6) Follow all standard conditions of the Sex Offender Unit; 7) Have no unsupervised contact with minors unless approved by the therapist and supervising probation officer; 8) Submit to and cooperate with polygraph testing per supervising agent; 9) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all standard conditions of probation; 10) Pursuant to §243.166, defendant be ordered to register as a predatory offender; and 11) Pursuant to

§609.119, defendant be ordered to provide biological specimen for the purposes of DNA analysis.

SENTENCE: 365 days w/339 days stayed for 2 years, \$3000 fine w/\$2700 stayed, on following conditions: 1) Serve 26 days in jail with credit for 26 days served. 2) Pay \$300 fine plus surcharges. 3) Complete a chemical dependency evaluation and follow all recommendations. 4) Abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at his own expense. 5) Maintain gainful employment and provide verification to probation officer. 6) No same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. 7) Cooperate with the transfer of his supervision to his County/State of residence.

SENTENCE: (1) Supervised probation; (2) serve 90 days in jail in either in-custody Sentence to Service, out-of-custody Sentence to Service or work release by December 31, 2008, with credit for 30 days served; serve an additional 45 days on in or out-of-custody Sentence to Service or Huber by September 1, 2009; serve additional 45 days by September 1, 2010 on in or out-of-custody Sentence to Service or work release; defendant was given a staggered sentence, and may petition the Court to suspend the jail time in 2009 and 2010, upon a showing that he had complied with all conditions of probation; (3) serve 30 days under electronic home monitoring for each year that he is on probation; (4) pay a \$50 fine and surcharges on a schedule to be determined by Court Administration; (5) attend the Chemical Dependency Recovery Group for one year; (6) attend a weekly self-help group of choice for one year; (7) abstain from the use of mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalyses; (8) attend a MADD VIP panel; (9) maintain gainful employment and provide verification to the supervising probation agent; (10) commit no same or similar offense, remain law abiding, have no alcohol-relating driving offenses and cooperate with probation; (11) cooperate with the transfer of supervision to his state of residence; (12) provide a biological specimen for DNA analysis; and (13) defendant is subject to a five-year conditional release, pursuant to the felony DUI statute.

The defendant shall be taken into custody today and shall complete a chemical dependency evaluation while in custody. The defendant may

complete Sentence to Service as a trustee. (2) Pay a fine of \$50 plus surcharges to be established by Court Administration. (3) Complete an evaluation for cognitive skills programming and follow all recommendations unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. (4) Complete all mental health programming unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. (5) Complete an updated chemical dependency evaluation and follow all recommendations, including aftercare plans unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. (6) Abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at defendant's own expense. Baseline urinalysis to be submitted at the time of sentencing. (7) Seek and maintain gainful employment and provide verification to the supervising probation officer. (8) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all of the standard conditions of probation. (9) Complete the Resources for the Unemployed and Determined Individual program.
