CONVICTION: Controlled Substance Crime in the 5th Degree  
SENTENCE: The defendant received the following felony sentence: A stay of adjudication for up to five years on the following conditions: 1) supervised probation for up to five years; 2) serve 13 days in jail, with credit for 13 days served; 3) complete a chemical dependency evaluation and follow all recommendations, including aftercare; 4) abstain from the use of mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random testing at his own expense; 5) have no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding, and cooperate with probation; 6) cooperate with the transfer of supervision to his county of residence, and 7) pay a \$100 fine, surcharge and law library fee.

SENTENCE: On Count 3, felony Criminal Sexual Conduct in the Third Degree, the Court stayed the imposition of sentence and placed the defendant on probation for a period of 15 years. The Court noted that the defendant is subject to a five year conditional release period of his sentence is ever executed. In addition to the standard conditions of probation, the Court ordered that: 1) The defendant serve 120 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 43 days served. The time may be served on work release and criteria is waived. The defendant is ordered to schedule a report date for serving the jail time. 2) Pay a fine of \$100 plus surcharges. 3) Have no direct or indirect contact with the victims. 4) Abstain from the use of all mood altering chemicals including alcohol and submit to random testing at his own expense. 5) Have no unsupervised contact with female minors until approved by a therapist trained in the evaluation and treatment of sexual offenders and approved by his supervising probation officer. The defendant may have contact with female minor co-workers while at work. 6) The defendant is ordered to enter into and successfully complete sex offender treatment and follow all recommendations of the treatment program. The treatment provider must be approved by the supervising probation officer. 7) The defendant is ordered to participate in and pay for any polygraph testing per the instructions of the supervising probation officer or treatment provider. 8) The defendant is ordered to follow all the standard conditions of the sex offender unit unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. The conditions are attached and are incorporated into the Court's order. 9) The defendant is ordered to have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. 10) The defendant is ordered to provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis. 11) The defendant is ordered to register as a predatory offender pursuant to §243.166.
