CONVICTION: Possession or Sale of Stolen or Counterfeit Check
SENTENCE: The Court committed the defendant to the Commissioner of Corrections for 13 months and Stayed the Execution of Sentence and placed the defendant on probation for a period of 5 years under the following conditions: 1) \$200 fine and serve 120 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 34 days served. 2) Abstain from the use of all mood altering chemicals, including alcohol and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at his own expense, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 3) Complete a chemical dependency evaluation within 15 days and follow all recommendations, including aftercare plans, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 4) Complete a Cognitive Skills Programming Intake in his county of residence, and follow all recommendations, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 5) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. 6) Cooperate with the transfer of his supervision to his county of residence. 7) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis

SENTENCE: On Count 1-Theft and Count 3 - Financial Transaction Card Fraud the court sentenced the defendant to a Stay of Imposition and placed the defendant on probation for 10 years under the following conditions: 1) Pay a \$50 fine and serve 30 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 1 day served. Can be done on in-custody Sentence to Service or out-of-custody Sentence to Service. 2) Defendant ordered to pay restitution of \$20,003.92 to Northland Homes; \$5,286.93 to Chase Bank Card Services and \$5,666.96 to GE Money Bank through Washington County Court Administration on a schedule to be established by the supervising probation officer. 3) Defendant ordered to complete all mental health programming/including taking all prescribed medication at the direction of the mental health professional, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 4) Defendant ordered to have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. 5) Defendant ordered to provide a biological specimen for DNA analysis.
