

**SENTENCING FOR

DATE: 8/5/2009

DEFENDANT: Harrison Nathaniel Spencer

DOB: 6/8/1959

CITY/RESIDENCE: St. Paul, MM

AGENCY: Woodbury Police Department

CONVICTION: Financial Transaction Card Fraud

SENTENCE: On the charge of Financial Transaction Card Fraud, the Court committed the defendant to the Commissioner of Corrections for a year and a day and stayed the execution of sentence and placed the defendant on probation for a period of 5 years under the following conditions: 1) Serve 61 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 61 days served, 2) Pay a fine of \$50 plus surcharges on a schedule to be established by Court Administration, 3) Pay restitution of \$267.06 to Woodbury Tires Plus through Washington County Court Administration, 4) Continue mental health programming with defendant's current mental health professional, 5) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation, 6) Cooperate with the transfer of his probation to his county/state of residence, 7) Report to Washington County Community Corrections immediately after release from jail for a Probation Intake, 8) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis.

SENTENCE: The defendant was committed to the Commissioner of Corrections for 42 months under a stay of execution and placed on probation for a period of 7 years subject to the following conditions: Serve 180 days in the Washington County Jail, pay a fine in the amount of \$50 plus surcharges, abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol and submit to random testing, comply with all recommended psychiatry and mental illness-chemical dependency case management, seek and maintain gainful employment and provide verification to supervising probation officer, remain law abiding, complete 30 days of Electronic Alcohol Monitoring per year, cooperate with transfer of probation to county of residence and provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis.

SENTENCE: The court committed the defendant to the Commissioner of Corrections for a period of 17 months with credit for time served of 260 days. The court ordered the defendant to pay a fine in the amount of \$50 plus surcharges to be deducted from prison wages and ordered the defendant to provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis.

SENTENCE: Gross Misdemeanor Sentence, 365 days and \$3,000 with 305 days and \$2,800 suspended for two years on conditions: 1) Defendant to serve 60 days in the Washington County jail. Time may be served on in or out-of-custody Sentence to Service; report 5/21/2010; 2) Pay a fine in the amount of \$200 plus surcharges; 3) Pay restitution in the amount of \$1,365 to victim through Washington County Court Administration; restitution to be paid joint and several with all co-defendants; 4) Abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at his own expense; 5) Maintain schooling or seek and maintain gainful employment and provide verification to the supervising probation officer; 6) Have no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation; and 7) Provide a biological specimen for the purposes of DNA analysis pursuant to 609.117.

SENTENCE: The court committed the defendant to the Commissioner of Corrections for a period of 21 months and stayed the execution of the sentence and placed the defendant on probation for a period of 5 years under the following conditions: 1) Serve 260 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 260 days served. 2) Pay a fine of \$50 plus surcharges. 3) Pay restitution through Washington County Court Administration on a schedule to be established by the supervising probation officer. Restitution is joint and several with co-defendant Christopher Lee Smith. The restitution amounts are as follows: victim \$430; victim \$500; victim \$100; victim \$149.44; victim \$6,587.97; victim \$170.14; victim \$67.43; victim \$660; victim \$696; victim \$764.43; victim \$4,171. 4) Abstain from the use of all mood altering chemicals including alcohol and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at his own expense. 5) Complete a chemical dependency evaluation and follow all recommendations including aftercare plans. 6) Comply with all recommendations stemming from his psychological evaluation including taking all medications at the direction of his mental health professional. 7) Seek and

maintain gainful employment or education and provide verification to the supervising probation officer. 8) Obtain his GED and provide verification to the supervising probation officer. 9) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all of the standard conditions of probation. 10) Cooperate with the transfer of supervision to his county of residence. 11) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis.

SENTENCE: On Count I the court stayed the imposition of sentence and placed the defendant on probation for a period of 5 years under the following conditions: 1) Serve 1 day in the Washington County Jail with credit for 1 day served. 2) Pay a fine of \$50 plus surcharges. 3) Perform 160 hours of Community Work Service within 12 months and provide written verification to the supervising probation officer. 4) Pay restitution in the amount of \$34,857.61 to the victim through Washington County Court Administration. The defendant presented a check for \$20,000 today and it will be submitted to Court Administration today per the plea agreement. 5) Have no same or similar offenses including no crimes of dishonesty, be law abiding and cooperate with all of the standard conditions of probation. 6) Provide a biological specimen for the purposes of DNA analysis.

SENTENCE: The court sentenced the defendant to a \$1000 fine and 90 days in jail with \$700 of the fine and 70 days in jail suspended and the defendant was placed on probation under the following conditions: 1) The defendant is placed on probation under the supervision of Washington County Community Corrections for a period of 2 years. 2) Serve 20 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 3 days served. Time to be served on out-of-custody Sentence to Service and criteria is waived. 3) Pay a fine of \$300 plus surcharges on a schedule to be established by Court Administration. 4) Have no direct or indirect contact with the victim. 5) Complete a psychological evaluation and follow all recommendations including paying for all associated costs and provide a copy to probation. 6) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all of the standard conditions of probation. 7) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis.

Defendant is ordered to pay a fine of \$50 to be deducted from prison wages, and ordered to pay restitution of \$1,235 to victim from future earnings at MN Correctional Facility.

SENTENCE: The court stayed the imposition of sentence and placed the defendant under the supervision of Washington County Community Corrections for a period of 5 years and noted that if the defendant's sentence is ever executed a 5 year conditional release period will apply. The court placed the defendant on probation under the following special conditions: 1) Serve 90 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 62 days served. 2) Pay a fine of \$500 plus

surcharges and the defendant has six months to pay the fine. 3) The court did not order the defendant to undergo a psycho-sexual evaluation and follow recommendations at this time because it is anticipated that the defendant will be deported within a short period of time. 4) No use of computers or access to the internet unless or until deemed appropriate by the supervising probation officer. 5) Abstain from the use of all mood altering chemicals including alcohol and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at his own expense. 6) Follow all of the standard conditions of the sex offender unit. 7) No contact with minors unless approved by his therapist and supervising probation officer. 8) Submit to and cooperate with polygraph testing. 9) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all of the standard conditions of probation. 10) Register as a predatory offender. 11) Provide a biological specimen for the purposes of DNA analysis. All other counts are dismissed.
