DEFENDANT: Victoria Lee Bowes

CONVICTION: Obstruct Legal Process

SENTENCE: Gross misdemeanor disposition, 365 days in jail, \$3,000 fine, 364 days and \$3,000 stayed for 5 years, credit for 1 day served, restitution to remain open for 30 days, complete all mental health programming, no use and submit to random testing, no same or similar, cognitive skills evaluation, no firearms, and provide a DNA sample.

SENTENCE: Stay of imposition of sentence for up to 10 years on the following conditions: (1) Supervised probation for up to 10 years; (2) Serve 30 days in the Washington County jail on the in-custody Sentence to Service program, with credit for 3 days served; (3) Pay restitution in the amount of \$7,060.79 to the victim through the Washington County Court Administrator's Office; (4) Complete a Cognitive Skills Programming evaluation and follow all recommendations; (5) Complete a psychological evaluation and follow all recommendations; (6) Complete a chemical dependency evaluation and follow all recommendations; (7) Complete a South Oaks Gambling Screen and follow all recommendations; (8) Have no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding, and cooperate with standard conditions of probation; (9) Complete a high school equivalency exam and provide proof to Community Corrections, or seek and maintain full time

employment, (10) Provide a biological specimen for DNA analysis; (11) Pay a \$50 fine and surcharges; (12) Obtain a RUDI (Resources for the Unemployed and Determined Individual) evaluation and follow all recommendations.

Execution of sentence was stayed and the defendant was placed on probation for 7 years with the following conditions: 1) serve 180 days with credit for 1 day, he is to do the first 60 days up front and can do that on work release, for the other two 60 day portions of the sentence, the defendant can do 320 hours of Community Work Service in lieu of the jail time, assuming he is doing everything and complying with all conditions of probation; 2) complete the Repeat Offender DUI Program; 3) participate in long term monitoring pursuant to 169A.277; 4) serve a minimum of 30 days of Electronic Home Monitoring per year; 5) abstain from chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random testing; 6) attend AA or NA two times per weeks for 12 months, provide verification; 7) no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding; 8) provide a DNA sample; 9) five year conditional release; 10) pay a \$500 fine.
