DEFENDANT: Leo William Poels

CITY/RESIDENCE: St Paul, MN  
AGENCY: Washington County Sheriff's Office  
CONVICTION: Aiding and Abetting Check Forgery  
SENTENCE: 19 months, stay of execution, 5 years probation on the following: 1) Defendant to serve 120 days, credit 120 days; 2) Defendant to comply with Ramsey County Drug Court conditions; 3) Restitution joint and several; \$200 fine. Remain law abiding, follow all conditions of probation.

If positive urinalysis in future, defendant to obtain a chemical dependency evaluation and follow recommendations; (3) No same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation; (4) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis; (5) Cooperate with the transfer of probation; (6) \$50 and surcharges.

contact with the victim, Target Corporation; (3) Complete an evaluation for Cognitive Skills Programming and follow all recommendations; (4) Ordered to abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol; (5) Complete a South Oaks Gambling Screen and follow all recommendations; (6) Cooperate with the transfer of his supervision to his county/state of residence; (7) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis; (8) Complete GED; (9) \$200 fine and surcharges, may be done through Community Work Service within 90 days.

SENTENCE: Stay of imposition for up to 5 years; (1) Serve 45 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 45 days served, time to be served on in-custody Sentence to Service or out-of-custody Sentence to Service; (2) Complete an intake for Cognitive Skills Programming if available in county of residence; (3) Complete a chemical dependency evaluation and follow all recommendations, including aftercare plans; (4) Abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at her own expense; (5) Complete a mental health evaluation and follow all recommendations; (6) Follow all standard conditions of Intensive Supervision Unit if she becomes a Washington County resident; (7) Have no same/similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all of the standard conditions of probation; (8) Cooperate with transfer of her supervision to her county/state of residence; (9) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis. (10) \$50 fine and surcharges.

Made sure Defendant understood he was on probation if he did not get deported. 90 days to be served as 60 days straight time and 30 days as Sentence to Service. Released to ICE hold today.
