

WASHINGTON COUNTY COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS
INTERNS/PROFESSIONALS IN TRAINING VOLUNTEERS

POSITION TITLE: SENTENCE TO SERVICE

GENERAL DESCRIPTION: Sentence to Service (STS) affords lower-risk offenders the opportunity to labor in organized work crews on various projects throughout the county. Interns/Volunteers in this program will have the opportunity to work with STS Crew Leaders as they supervise offenders on work projects for public, private non-profit, and government agencies. Work projects include cutting grass and shoveling snow for elderly/disabled individuals, trail and prairie restoration for state and county agencies, recycling for county buildings, natural disaster relief, painting, clean-up, and general maintenance. STS is used as a jail alternative program for adult offenders, while juvenile STS is used as a structured community work service option for juvenile offenders.

EXAMPLES OF WORK:

1. Observe the crew leader's supervision of the crew.
2. Actively participate alongside crew members in job-site physical labor, as directed by Crew Leader.

SUPERVISION: Interns/Volunteers will be under the direct supervision of the Sentence to Service Crew Leader. Interns/Volunteers will also work with the STS Unit Supervisor.

WORK SITES: Washington County Courthouse/Government Center/Law Enforcement Center, Stillwater, MN, and various sites throughout the County.

TIME REQUIREMENT: Minimum requirement is 40 hours. Applicants interested in placement with the Juvenile STS Program must be available to work on Saturdays.

QUALIFICATIONS: Interns/Volunteers shall have completed at least one year of college-level work in a related field.

Candidates must also meet the Department Standards and Criteria attached.
