CONVICTION: 5th Degree Controlled Substance Crime

SENTENCE: (1) Supervised probation for up to five years; (2) serve five days in jail, with credit for five days served; (3) obtain a chemical dependency evaluation and follow all recommendations, including aftercare; (4) abstain from the use of mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalyses at his own expense; (5) have no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding, and abide by all standard conditions of probation; (6) cooperate with the transfer of probation to Wisconsin, and (7) pay a \$300 fine and surcharges within 60 days.

SENTENCE: Court stayed imposition of sentence and placed defendant on probation for 5 years under the following conditions: 1) Serve 20 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for one day served; time to be served on the out-of-custody Sentence to Service program. 2) Abstain from the use of all mood altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at his own expense, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 3) Pay restitution of \$4,480.20 to the victims through the Washington County Court Administration on a schedule to be established by the supervising probation officer. Restitution

should be paid joint and several with the co-defendant. 4) Seek and maintain gainful employment and/or education and provide verification to the supervising probation officer. 5) Complete the (RUDI) Resources for the Unemployed and Determined Individual Program unless supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 6) No same or similar offenses; remain law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. 7) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis.

Pay fine of \$50 plus fees. Defendant will be taken into custody today to begin serving sentence.
