## **Washington County spring load limit restrictions become effective March 8**

The Washington County Public Works Department announced that the 2010 spring load limit restrictions for Washington County roads will become effective as of 12:01 a.m., Monday, March 8. The spring road restrictions will stay in effect for eight weeks or unless special circumstances dictate otherwise.

All county roads with spring weight restrictions will be posted with signs indicating the spring load limit for a particular road. During spring weight restrictions, Washington County does not issue permits for overweight transport, except in cases of a serious public health emergency. Call the Washington County Public Works Department at 651-430-4300 with questions on emergency permits.
