SENTENCE: 40 days in jail, with credit for time served.

CONVICTION: Terroristic Threats
SENTENCE: Imposition of sentence was stayed and the defendant was placed on probation for five years with the following conditions: 1) 30 days jail with credit for 14 days, can be done on in-custody Sentence to Service; 2) \$50 fine plus surcharge; 3) complete updated mental health evaluation and follow the recommendations; 4) complete chemical dependence evaluation and follow the recommendations; 5) abstain from the use of chemicals, including alcohol, submit to random testing; 6) no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding; 7) cooperate with the transfer of probation; 8) provide a DNA sample.

CONVICTION: Controlled Substance Crime 4th Degree
SENTENCE: 5 years probation, 20 days jail, \$500 fine, Psychiatric evaluation & follow recommendations, abstain from chemicals & alcohol, submit to random testing, chemical dependency evaluation & follow recommendations, maintain employment, remain law abiding, DNA sample.

DEFENDANT: Randy Dwayne Weeks

AGENCY: Cottage Grove Police Department
CONVICTION: Burglary in the 3rd Degree
SENTENCE: Defendant was committed to the Commissioner of Corrections for 18 months and execution of the sentence was stayed. The defendant was placed on probation for a period of up to 10 years under the following conditions: 1) Serve 75 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for time served at the Washington County Jail and Olmsted County Jail. The sentence is to run concurrent with the Olmsted County case. Time to be served on Work Release or in- or out-of-custody Sentence to Service, and criteria is waived by the Court. 2) Pay a fine of \$50 plus surcharges. 3) Pay restitution if requested within 30 days of sentencing. 4) Have no direct or indirect contact with the victim or his residence. 5) Complete an evaluation for Cognitive Skills Programming and follow all recommendations. 6) Complete inpatient/outpatient chemical dependency treatment. 7) Abstain from the use of all mood altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at his own expense. 8) Seek and maintain gainful employment and provide verification to the supervising probation officer. 9) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. 10) Follow all the standard conditions of the Intensive Supervision Unit, if defendant is a Washington County resident, unless the supervision probation officer deems it unnecessary. 11) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis. 12) Cooperate with the transfer of his probation to his county of residence.
