DEFENDANT: Gina Aretta Andrew

CONVICTION: Offering a Forged Check

SENTENCE: The defendant was committed to the Commissioner of Corrections for 13 months and she is to receive credit for 353 days. She is to pay restitution to Kohl's in the amount of \$339.78 and to Menard's in the amount of \$247.48. She is to provide a DNA sample and pay a \$50 fine plus surcharge.

Serve 30 additional days on in-custody Sentence to Service after Christmas. Review Hearing in December 2009. Court will decide what to do with remaining jail time (balance is 180 days - about 90 days remaining). 2) Pay \$50 fine plus surcharges within 45 days. 3) Complete all mental health programming, including taking all prescribed medication at the direction of the mental health professional, including cognitive skills if appropriate. 4) Abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis/Breathalyzers at his own expense. Defendant ordered to provide a baseline urinalysis on the day of sentencing. 5) Attend AA/NA meetings 2 times per week for 12 months and provide verification. 6) Seek and maintain gainful employment and provide verification. 7) Cooperate with the transfer of his supervision to his County/State of

residence. 8) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. 9) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis.

indirect contact with victim or victim's immediate family. 5) Ordered to actively participate in and successfully complete sex offender specific treatment and follow all recommendations. 6) Abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis/Breathalyzers at own expense, at least through age of 21, obtain a chemical dependency evaluation and follow all recommendations. 7) Follow all the standard conditions of Sex Offender Unit. 8) No unsupervised contact with minors unless approved by the therapist. SENTENCE: A stay of imposition of sentence for up to five years on the following conditions: 1) Supervised probation for up to five years; 2) Serve 90 days in jail, with credit for time served; the defendant may serve the jail on the in-custody Sentence to Service program, or Huber; 3) Pay a \$50 fine and surcharges on a schedule to be determined by Court Administration; 4) Restitution was left open for a period of 30 days; 5) Defendant to have no contact with victims; 6) Defendant to complete a Cognitive Skills Programming evaluation and follow all recommendations, including any recommendation as to chemical dependency treatment; 7) Defendant to meet with his Hennepin County probation agent regarding programming for domestic abuse and/or

Defendant to complete 100 hours of Community Work Service within six months; 2) Defendant be ordered to pay a fine in the amount of \$50, plus surcharges on a schedule to be established by Court Administration; 3) Defendant be ordered to abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis/Breathalyzers at her own expense, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. If defendant submits a positive urine screen, defendant should be ordered to complete an updated chemical dependency evaluation and follow all recommendations, including aftercare plans, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. Successfully complete Progress Valley treatment; 4) Defendant be ordered to attend AA/NA meetings 2 times per week for 6 months and provide verification to the supervising probation officer; 5) Defendant be ordered to complete all mental health programming/including taking all prescribed medication at the direction of the mental health professional, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary; 6) Defendant be ordered to complete an evaluation for Cognitive Skills Programming if available in county of residence, and follow all recommendations, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary; 7) Defendant be ordered to have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation; and 8) Defendant be ordered to cooperate with the transfer of her supervision to her county of residence.
