DEFENDANT: Stephen James Kelley

CONVICTION: Assault in the Third Degree

SENTENCE: Stay of imposition of sentence, 5 years of probation, 20 days of jail, \$500 fine, \$278.89 restitution to victim, no contact with victim, participate in all chemical dependency and mental health services as recommended by the Veterans Administration, comply with anger management, abstain from alcohol/chemicals, random testing, remain law abiding, and provide a DNA sample.

Defendant to begin serving in April 2009 on Electronic Home Monitoring. 3) Pay \$500 fine, plus surcharges. 4) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. 5) Meet with the Minnesota Department of Revenue within 30 days of sentencing to begin the audit process to determine an amount of restitution due. Full restitution payment not a condition of probation; okay from representative of MN Department of Revenue. 6) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis.

For the Failure to Pay or Collect charge: \$3,000 fine and 365 days in jail with \$2,500 of the fine and 335 days in jail suspended for 2 years under the following conditions: 1) Placed on probation for 2 years. 2) Ordered to serve 15 days in jail consecutive to the Failure to File Return charge. To be served on Electronic Home Monitoring to begin on April 1, 2009. 3) Pay \$500 fine plus surcharges, consecutive to Failure to File Return charge above. 4) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. 5) Meet with the Minnesota Department of Revenue within 30 days of Sentencing, to begin the audit process to determine an amount of restitution due. 6) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis.
