SENTENCE: Imposition of sentence was stayed and the defendant was placed on probation for five years with the following conditions: 1) serve 15 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 5 days served; 2) pay a fine of \$50 plus surcharges; 3) pay restitution; 4) seek and maintain gainful employment and provide verification; 5) have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all standard conditions of probation; 6) cooperate with the transfer of his supervision to his county of residence; 7) provide a DNA sample.

The defendant will serve the time as straight time, and the court gave him 45 days to report to the jail. 2) Pay a fine in the amount of \$300 plus surcharges on a schedule to be established by Court Administration. 3) Complete a chemical dependency evaluation and follow all recommendations. 4) Abstain from alcohol and all illegal substances. 5) Submit to random urinalysis testing at defendant's own expense and at the direction of his supervising probation officer. 6) Defendant is ordered to provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis. 7) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation.
