CONVICTION: Controlled Substance Crime in the Fifth Degree
SENTENCE: Committed to the Commissioner of Corrections for 19 months under a stay of execution of sentence. \$50 fine plus surcharges. The defendant requested execution of his sentence, which was granted.

Time may be served on any out-of-custody alternative with criteria waived. 2) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. 3) Cooperate with the transfer of his supervision to his county or state of residence. 4) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis. 5) Pay a fine of \$100 plus surcharges.

Court staggered sentence; ordered 365 days to be served over six years on 60 day installments. First year - 60 days, with credit for 31 days and balance to be served after completed Teen Challenge. Remaining 365 days served as 61 day increments, on staggered sentencing and can ask to be waived over six years. 2) Participate in long term monitoring; a minimum of 30 days of Electronic Home Monitoring per year of probation, in addition to any jail time served while on probation. First installment to be served in 2011 during Christmas. After that, defendant can ask that long term monitoring be waived. 3) Ordered to complete an intake for Cognitive Skills programming and follow all recommendations. 4) Complete all mental health programming; including taking all prescribed medication at the direction of the mental health professional. 5) Ordered to complete a chemical dependency program such as Teen Challenge and follow all recommendations. 6) Abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random testing at own expense. 7) Attend AA/NA meetings once per week for 12 months and provide verification to the supervising probation officer. 8) Attend a MADD Victim Impact Panel. 9) Complete the Repeat Offender DWI program, if she becomes a Washington County resident or if available in county of residence. 10) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. 11) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis. 12) Pay a \$50 fine plus fees
