DEFENDANT: Michael Paul Klabunde

AGENCY: Washington County Sheriff's Office

CONVICTION: Aggravated Forgery-Utter or Possess Writing/Object

SENTENCE: The court stayed the imposition of sentence and placed the defendant on probation for 5 years under the following conditions: 1) Serve 25 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 1 day served. The time may be served on out-of-custody Sentence to Service. 2) Pay a fine of \$200 plus surcharges. 3) Pay restitution of \$3,063 and \$172.25 to Ambassador Press Inc. through Washington County Court Administration. 4) The court leaves open restitution for expenses and attorney's fees for Land O'Lakes. 5) Maintain gainful employment and provide verification to the supervising probation officer. 6) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all of the standard conditions of probation. 7) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis.

To be served on Work Release, if criteria waived; 2) pay \$150 fine plus surcharges; 3) no direct or indirect contact with the victim; 4) pay any restitution to remain open for 6 months; 5) complete a psycho-sexual evaluation at Human Services, Inc. and follow all recommendations; 6) abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random testing at own expense; 7) follow all the standard conditions of the Sex Offender Unit; 8) participate in and pay for any polygraph testing; 9) no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation.

SENTENCE: Serve 365 days in jail and pay a \$3000 fine, with 275 days and \$2850 suspended for 2 years and be placed on probation for two years on the following special conditions: 1) serve 90 days in jail with credit for 4 days, concurrent to other 5th Degree Criminal Sexual Conduct charge. To be served on Work Release, if criteria waived; 2) pay \$150 fine plus surcharges; 3) no direct or indirect contact with the victim; 4) complete a psycho-sexual evaluation at Human Services, Inc. and follow all recommendations; 5) abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random testing at own expense; 6) follow all the standard conditions of the Sex Offender Unit; 7) participate in and pay for any polygraph testing; 8) no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation; 9) register as a predatory offender; 10) provide a DNA sample per statute.

SENTENCE: The court stayed the imposition of sentence and placed the defendant on probation for 10 years and noted that if the defendant's sentence is ever executed, a 10 year conditional release period will apply. The defendant was placed on probation under the following conditions:

1) Serve 67 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 3 days served. The time may be served on in-custody Sentence to Service. 2) Pay a fine of \$300 plus surcharges on a schedule to be established by Court Administration. 3) Have no direct or indirect contact with the victim or victim's family. 4) Have no unsupervised contact with female minors under the age of 18 years old not including his own children and step-children until it has been determined to be appropriate by a therapist trained in the evaluation and treatment of sexual offenders and his supervising probation officer. 5) Participate in and pay for any polygraph testing as instructed as a part of any treatment or at the request of the supervising probation officer. 6) Pay any restitution through Washington County Court Administration on a schedule to be established by the supervising probation officer and restitution is to remain open for 1 year. 7) Abstain from the use of all mood altering chemicals including alcohol and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at his own expense. 8) Enter and complete sex offender treatment and follow all recommendations. Each treatment provider must be approved by the supervising probation officer. 9) Attend AA meetings one time per week for 12 months and provide verification to the supervising probation officer. 10) Follow all of the standard conditions of the sex offender unit. 11) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. 12) Cooperate with the transfer of his supervision to his county of residence. 13) Register as a predatory offender. 14) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis.

SENTENCE: The defendant was committed to the Commissioner of Corrections for a period of 13 months under a stay of execution of sentence and placed on probation for a period of 5 years, subject to the following conditions: (1) The defendant is ordered to serve 118 days in the Washington County jail with credit for 118 days served; (2) The defendant is ordered to pay a fine in the amount of \$100 plus surcharges on a schedule to be established by Court Administration; (3) Pay restitution in the amount of \$1,557.92 to Wipers Recycling LLC; (4) Have no direct or indirect contact with the victims; (5) Complete an evaluation for Cognitive Skills Programming and follow all recommendations; (6) Complete a chemical dependency evaluation; (7) Seek and maintain gainful employment and provide verification; (8) Complete the RUDI (Resources for the Unemployed and Determined Individual) Program; (9) Complete a South Oaks Gambling Screen; (10) Follow all standard conditions of Intensive Supervision Unit;

SENTENCE: 18 months in prison, execution stayed for up to five years on the following conditions: (1) supervised probation for up to five years; (2) serve 113 days in jail, with credit for 92 days served; (3) pay a \$50 fine and surcharges on a schedule to be determined by Court Administration; (4) complete a Cognitive Skills Programming evaluation and follow all recommendations; (5) complete a mental health and anger management evaluation and follow all recommendations; (6) complete an updated chemical dependency evaluation and follow all recommendations; (7) comply with the rules of the Intensive Supervision Unit; (8) abstain from the use of mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalyses at his own expense; (9) seek and maintain gainful employment and provide verification to the supervising probation agent and participate in the RUDI (Resources for the Unemployed and Determined Individual) Program, if appropriate, and (10) have no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding, and cooperate with standard conditions of probation.
