

**SENTENCING FOR  
THE WEEK OF 12/27/2010**

DATE: 12/27/2010  
DEFENDANT: Dawn Marie Rasset  
DOB: 7/18/1968  
CITY/RESIDENCE: Maplewood, MN  
AGENCY: Washington County Sheriff's Office  
CONVICTION: Financial Transaction Card Fraud; Identity Theft  
SENTENCE: On Count 2, felony Financial Transaction Card Fraud, the Court committed the defendant to the Commissioner of Corrections for 21 months and stayed the execution of sentence and placed the defendant on probation for 5 years under the following conditions: 1) Serve 365 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 94 days served; the time may be served on work release or in custody sentence to service with a start date in February 2011. 2) Complete a chemical dependency evaluation and follow all recommendations including aftercare plans. 3) Abstain from the use of all mood altering chemicals including alcohol and submit to random testing at her own expense. 4) Complete an intake for Cognitive Skills Programming and follow all recommendations if available in county of residence. 5) Have no direct or indirect contact with the victims. 6) Complete all mental health programming including taking all prescribed medication at the direction of the mental health professional. 7) Seek and maintain gainful employment and provide verification to the supervising probation officer. 8) Follow all the standard conditions of the Intensive Supervision Unit if a Washington County resident. 9) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. 10) Cooperate with the transfer of her supervision to her county of residence. 11) Pay a fine of \$250.00. 12) Pay restitution in the amount of \$1,332.49 to victim on the schedule to be determined by the supervising probation officer. On Count 3, felony Identity Theft, the Court committed the defendant to the Commissioner of Corrections for 21 months and stayed the Execution of Sentence and place the defendant on probation for five years under the same conditions as set forth in Count 2 and the additional condition that the defendant pay restitution to victim in the amount of \$1,000.00.

SENTENCE: The Court gave Defendant a Gross Misdemeanor on count 2 - 365 days w/305 days stayed, \$3,000 fine with \$2100 stayed; 2 years probation; serve 60 days in custody with work release; credit for 6 days served; complete mental health evaluation and follow recommendations; updated chemical dependency evaluation and follow recommendations; abstain and no use/random testing; no same or similar offenses and remain law abiding; DNA sample; pay \$900 fine plus fees. On count 3, 365 days with 305 suspended for 3 years probation; \$3,000 fine with \$2,900 stayed, on following conditions: 1) Serve 60 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 6 days. Time to be served concurrent with County 3. Time may be served on work release. 2) Complete a mental health evaluation and follow all recommendations for

programming unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 3) Complete an updated chemical dependency evaluation and follow all recommendations, including aftercare plans, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 4) Abstain from the use of all mood altering chemicals, including alcohol and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at his own expense, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 5) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. 6) Defendant ordered to provide a biological specimen for DNA analysis

Pay \$200 fine plus fees.

Time to be served on in custody Sentence to Service, out of custody Sentence to Service or Work Release, if qualified. 2) Defendant ordered to pay restitution in the amount to be determined within 30 days of sentencing through Washington County Court Administration on a schedule to be established by the supervising probation officer. Restitution to be joint and several with Co-Defendants Dylan Ross, Basil Sampair and James Redshaw. 3) Defendant ordered to have no direct or indirect contact with victim(s) or

residence. 4) Defendant ordered to complete book-in motion and provide fingerprints at the Washington County Sheriff's office. 5) Defendant ordered to have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. 6) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis.

SENTENCE: On the charge of Aiding & Abetting Receiving Stolen Property, the Court committed the defendant to the Commissioner of Corrections for 13 months and stayed the execution of sentence and placed the defendant on probation for 5 years under the following conditions: 1) Serve 180 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 180 days served. 2) Pay restitution of \$314.62 to victim through Washington County Court Administration on a schedule to be established by the supervising probation officer. 3) Have no direct or indirect contact with the victim or his residence. 4) Abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals including alcohol and submit to random testing at his own expense. 5) Complete a chemical dependency evaluation within 30 days of release from custody and follow all recommendations including aftercare plans. 6) Complete a cognitive skills programming intake in his county of residence and follow all recommendations. 7) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. 8) Cooperate with the transfer of his supervision to his county of residence if eligible. 9) Defendant has previously provided a biological specimen for DNA analysis. 10) Pay a fine of \$200 plus surcharges.
