The court placed the defendant on probation under the same conditions as set forth in Count III with the following changes: 1) the 13 days to be served shall be concurrent to the 13 days on Count 3 and therefore there is no additional time to serve at this time; 2) defendant is ordered to pay a fine in the amount of \$50 on this count which is consecutive to the fine on Count III, but the court waived the surcharges and law library fee; 3) defendant is ordered to complete a South Oaks Gambling Screen and follow all recommendations unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary.
