

**SENTENCING FOR  
THE WEEK OF 6/14/2010**

DATE: 6/11/2010  
DEFENDANT: Maxfield Lake Weizenegger  
DOB: 11/11/1986  
CITY/RESIDENCE: Minneapolis, MN  
AGENCY: Oakdale Police Department  
CONVICTION: Motor Vehicle Theft  
SENTENCE: The Court committed the defendant to the Commissioner of Corrections for 13 months and stayed the execution of the sentence and placed the defendant on probation for a period of five years under the following conditions: 1) Serve 99 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 99 days served; 2) Pay restitution in the amount of \$652.16 to victim; 3) Have no direct or indirect contact with the victims; 4) Complete an evaluation for cognitive skills programming and follow all recommendations unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary; 5) Complete a psychological evaluation and follow through with psychiatric services and therapy as directed by the mental health case manager; 6) Complete an updated chemical dependency evaluation if requested by probation or enter a halfway house at the direction of Guild or his Ramsey County case manager; 7) Abstain from the use of all mood altering chemicals including alcohol and submit to random testing at his own expense; 8) Attend AA/NA meetings two times per week for 12 months and provide verification to the supervising probation officer unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary; 9) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation; 10) The defendant has previously submitted a biological specimen for DNA analysis; 11) Follow all orders and recommendations from the mental health court in Hennepin County; 12) Cooperate with the transfer of probation to his county or state of residence; 13) Follow any in-patient mental illness/chemical dependency programming recommendations; 14) Take all prescribed medications as prescribed by the defendant's physician; 15) Pay a \$50 fine plus surcharges; and 16) If the defendant ever becomes a Washington County resident while on probation, he'll be subject to intensive supervision.

Placed on probation for two years under the following conditions: 1) have no direct or indirect contact with the victims; 2) abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random testing; 3) have no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding, and cooperate with all standard conditions of probation; 4) cooperate with the transfer of supervision to his county of residence; 5) provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis; 6) pay a fine of \$100 plus surcharges and fees within 180 days.

years with the following conditions: 1) serve 44 days jail with credit for 44 days served; 2) pay restitution of \$4,803.76 to Gander Mountain; 3) no contact with Gander Mountain; 4) remain law abiding, have no same or similar offenses, cooperate with all standard conditions of probation.

Time to be served on in or out-of-custody Sentence to Service, criteria waived; 2) Abstain from the use of all mood altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at his own expense, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary; 3) Complete aftercare at Avalon and follow any recommendations; 4) Attend AA/NA meetings one time per week for 12 months and provide verification to the supervising probation officer; 5) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation and cooperate with transfer of probation. 6) Pursuant to §609.117, defendant ordered to provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis, and 7) \$50 fine plus surcharges.

Execution of sentence was stayed and the defendant was placed on probation for 3 years with the following conditions: 1) Serve 30 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 3 days served, time may be done on Work Release or in- or out-of-custody Sentenced to Service; 2) complete an evaluation for Cognitive Skills Programming if available in County of residence and follow all recommendations; 3) have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation; 4) cooperate with the transfer of supervision to County/State of residence; 5) provide a DNA sample.

SENTENCE: On Count I: The defendant was given a stay of adjudication and placed on probation for five years with the following conditions: 1) serve 3 days jail with credit for 3 days served; 2) complete a chemical dependency evaluation and chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random testing; 4) have no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. On Count II: The defendant was given 90 days jail with 70 days suspended for one year on the following conditions: 1) serve 20 days in jail with credit for 3 days served, time to be concurrent with Count I; 2) have no contact with the victim or her son; 3) complete a chemical dependency evaluation within 10 days and follow all recommendations; 4) abstain from all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, submit to random testing; 5) have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, cooperate with all

standard conditions of probation; 6) cooperate with the transfer of supervision to county/state of residence; 7) complete an anger management and/or domestic abuse treatment program; 8) complete intake for a 12-session Women's Group.
