DEFENDANT: Norman Leroy Randall

CONVICTION: Offering a Forged Check
SENTENCE: Defendant was sentenced to 16 months in prison and eight months on supervised release; he is to pay a \$50 fine plus surcharges on a schedule to be established by Court Administration; pay restitution through Washington County Court Administration, restitution to be joint and several with any co-defendants.

CONVICTION: Predatory Offender Registration Violation
SENTENCE: Defendant was committed to the Commissioner of Corrections for 16 months, execution was stayed and he was placed on probation for up to five years on the following conditions: (1) serve 180 days with credit for 31 days; (2) pay a \$50 fine plus fees, (3) have a chemical dependency evaluation and follow recommendations; (4) comply with probation and sex offender unit; (5) comply with registration requirements; (6) have no same or similar offenses and remain law abiding; balance of jail can be served on in-custody Sentence to Service, criteria waived.

SENTENCE: Defendant was sentenced to \$3,000 fine and 365 days in jail, with 363 days and \$2,950 suspended for a period of two years on the following conditions: (1) Serve 2 days in jail, with credit for 2 days; (2) Pay fine of \$50 plus surcharge; (3) Complete an evaluation for domestic abuse and/or anger management and follow recommendations; (4) Complete the Haven 16-hour educational program as recommended by chemical

dependency evaluation; (5) Abstain from use of all mood-altering chemicals and submit to random testing; (6) Remain law abiding; (7) Provide DNA sample pursuant to 609.117.

(1) Defendant serve 20 days in jail, with credit for 3 days served; (2) Defendant pay a fine of \$800 plus surcharges; (3) Defendant ordered to perform 40 hours of Community Work Service; (4) Defendant have no direct or indirect contact with victim; (5) Defendant complete Victim Offender Conferencing unless supervising probation officer deems unnecessary; (6) Complete an evaluation for domestic abuse and/or anger management and follow recommendations; (7) Seek and maintain gainful employment and/or college and provide verification; (8) Have no same/similar offenses and remain law abiding; (9) Pursuant to 609.117, give a biological specimen for DNA analysis purposes.

CONVICTION: Controlled Substance Crime in the Fifth Degree and Obstructing Legal Process with Force
SENTENCE: On the charge of Fifth Degree Controlled Substance: (1) probation for five years; (2) defendant to serve 15 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for six days served, to be served on in-custody Sentence to Service or turn in before 3/15/08; (3) pay a \$50 fine plus surcharges on a schedule to be established by Court Administration; (4) abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalyses/breathalyzers at his own expense, unless the supervising probation agent deems it unnecessary; (5) attend AA/NA meetings one time per week for 12 months and provide verification to the supervising probation officer; (6) have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation.

On the charge of Obstructing Legal Process with Force: defendant is sentenced to \$1,000/90 days with \$950/75 days suspended for two years on the following conditions: (1) probation for two years; (2) serve 15 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for six days served; time to be served on in-custody Sentence to Service or turn in before 3/15/08; (3) pay a \$50 fine on a schedule to be established by Court Administration; (4) abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalyses/breathalyzers at his own expense, unless the supervising probation agent deems it unnecessary; (5) attend AA/NA meetings one time per week for 12 months and provide verification to the supervising probation agent; and

(6) have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation.
