

**SENTENCING FOR
THE WEEK OF 5/18/2009**

DATE: 5/14/2009

DEFENDANT: Joseph Albert Ives

DOB: 11/21/1966

CITY/RESIDENCE: Stillwater, MN

AGENCY: Oak Park Heights Police Department

CONVICTION: Check Forgery - Falsely Endorse

SENTENCE: The court sentenced this as a Gross Misdemeanor and placed the defendant on probation for a period of 2 years under the following conditions: 1) Serve 365 days with 345 days suspended with credit for 3 days served. The time may be served as out-of-custody Sentence to Service. 2) Pay a fine of \$3,000 with \$2,900 suspended plus surcharges on a schedule to be established by Court Administration. 3) Continue all mental health programming including taking all prescribed medication at the directions of the mental health professional unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 4) Have no same or similar offenses and be law abiding and cooperate with all of the standard conditions of probation. 5) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis. 6) 40 hours of Community Work Service by 10/1/09.

CONVICTION: Financial Exploitation - Vulnerable Adult - Fail Provide Care

SENTENCE: The court stayed the imposition of sentence and placed the defendant on probation for a period of 5 years on the following conditions: 1) Serve 15 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 1 day served. The time may be served on Electronic Home Monitoring and the defendant may do orientation in September 2009. 2) Pay a fine of \$200 plus surcharges. 3) Pay restitution in the amount of \$5,275 to Woodbury Villas, \$1,197.13 to Woodbury Healthcare Center, and \$7,426.46 to Washington County Community Services. The defendant provided checks in those amounts to probation today. 4) Complete all mental health programming including taking all prescribed medication at the direction of the mental health professional unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 5) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all of the standard conditions of probation. 6) Pursuant to Statute 609.117 provide a biological specimen for purposed of DNA analysis

SENTENCE: Court sentenced the defendant to 365 days in jail and a \$3,000 fine. 180 days and \$2,950 of the fine suspended for a period of three years on the following conditions: Defendant serve 180 days on Electronic Home Monitoring; pay fine in the amount of \$50, plus surcharges; abstain from the use of mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol and submit to random testing; attend AA/NA meetings once per week for 6 months and provide verification to supervising officer; have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all of the standard conditions of probation; cooperate with the transfer of supervision to county of residence; defendant to remain in Sober House at direction of supervising probation officer; and receive an updated chemical dependency evaluation and follow recommendations regarding where he is to live.

SENTENCE: The court stayed the adjudication of sentence pursuant to 152.18 and placed defendant on probation for 5 years under the following conditions: 1) Serve 1 day in the Washington County Jail with credit for 1 day served. 2) Pay a fine of \$300 plus surcharges. 3) Perform 80 hours of Community Work Service by 10/1/09. 4) Continue current mental health programming including taking all prescribed medication at the direction of the mental health professional unless the mental health professional deems it unnecessary. 5) Abstain from the use of all mood altering chemicals including alcohol and submit to testing, specifically hair sample testing unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 6) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all of the standard conditions of probation.

Count II: The defendant was given 90 days with 75 days suspended and a \$1,000 fine with \$500 suspended with the following conditions: 1) 2 years probation; 2) complete a chemical dependency evaluation and follow the recommendations; 3) participate in MADD Impact Panel; 4) have no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding.
