SENTENCE: Three years probation, intensive supervision for repeat offender program in his county of residence; pay a \$900 fine plus surcharges on a schedule to be established by Court Administration; attend AA twice per week for 12 months and provide verification; attend a MADD Victim Impact Panel unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary; serve 30 days on Electronic Home Monitoring; cooperate with the transfer of his supervision to his county of residence, and provide a biological specimen for DNA purposes.

The Court also noted on the record that if the defendant's probation is revoked and his sentence is executed, a 5 year conditional release will be imposed. The conditions of probation are as follows: 1) serve 212 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 212 days, 2) pay a fine of \$50 plus surcharges, 3) have no direct or indirect contact with the victim, 4) enter and complete sex offender treatment and follow all recommendations. Treatment provider must be approved by supervising probation officer, 5) have no contact with female minors under the age of 18 years old until it has been determined to be appropriate by a therapist trained in the evaluation and treatment of sexual offenders and his supervising probation officer. Also defendant is to have no unsupervised contact with his minor daughter. The minor daughter's mother or other reasonable person may supervise such contact. 6) participate in and pay for any polygraph testing per the instructions of the supervising probation officer, 7) abstain from the use of all mood altering chemicals including alcohol and submit to random urinalysis and breathalyzers at his own expense unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary, 8) follow all the standard conditions of the sex offender unit unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary, 9) have no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation, 10) register as a predatory offender pursuant to § 243.166, 11) provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis, 12) defendant is to contact his Washington County Probation Officer upon release from incarceration in Iowa.

The Court placed the defendant on probation under the following conditions: 1) serve 6 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for time served, 2) pay a fine in the amount of \$500 plus surcharges on a schedule to be established by Court Administration, 3) based on information given to the Court by Community Corrections, the Court noted on the record that the defendant has completed the DUI First Offender Program at Human Services Agency, 4) defendant is ordered to abstain from the use of all mood altering chemicals including alcohol and is to submit to random urinalysis and breathalyzers at his own expense unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary, baseline to be provided on date of sentencing, 5) have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation, 6) cooperate with the transfer of his supervision to his county or state of residence.
