CONVICTION: Gross Misdemeanor Financial Transaction Card Fraud

SENTENCE: \$3,000 fine and 365 days in jail, with \$2,700 and 360 days suspended for one year on the following conditions: (1) probation to the Court for one year; (2) pay a \$300 fine and surcharges today; (3) serve five days in jail, with credit for five days served, and (4) commit no same or similar offenses.

The time may be served as 152 hours of Community Work Service in the defendant's county of residence. 2) Pay a fine of \$50 plus surcharges on a schedule to be established by Court Administration. 3) Complete all mental health programming including taking all prescribed medication at the direction of the mental health professional unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 4) Seek and maintain gainful employment and provide verification to the supervising probation officer. 5) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. 6) Cooperate with the transfer of her supervision to her county of residence. 7) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis.

Defendant to register as a Predatory Offender for the duration of his lifetime pursuant to 243.166. Pursuant to 609.117, defendant to provide a biological specimen for DNA analysis.
