CONVICTION: Drugs - Fifth Degree

SENTENCE: Stay of adjudication pursuant to 152.18, 5 years probation on the following:

1) Defendant to serve 19 days with credit for 19 days; 2) \$50 fine plus surcharges; 3) Cognitive skills evaluation and recommendations; 4) Abstain including alcohol and random testing; 5) Attend AA/NA once a week for six months and provide verification; 6) Defendant to seek and maintain gainful employment and provide verification; 7) No same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with standard conditions of probation; 8) Cooperate with transfer of probation.

CONVICTION: II: Gross Misdemeanor Harassment; III: Gross Misdemeanor 3rd Degree Criminal Damage to Property

SENTENCE: Count II: Gross Misdemeanor Harassment: The defendant was given a \$3,000 fine and 365 days jail. \$2,500 of the fine and 275 days of the jail time were suspended for two years on the following conditions: 1) serve 90 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 7 days served, which can be done on Work Release or in-custody Sentence to Service, and he can be furloughed for medical appointments; 2) pay a fine of \$500 plus surcharges; 3) pay restitution of \$517 plus additional costs incurred if requested within 30 days of sentencing to the victim; 4) have no direct or in-direct contact with the victim, his residence, his family, or his place of employment; 5) complete an evaluation with a forensic psychologist and follow all recommendations for treatment plan, including taking all prescribed medication at the direction of the mental

health professional; 6) abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random testing; 7) have no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding, cooperate with all standard conditions of probation; 8) have no weapons, no incendiary devices, or materials that can be used to make weapons; 9) submit his person, residence, office, computer, or vehicle to a random search, conducted by a probation officer or agent of the probation office, and warn any other residents that the premises may be subject to searches pursuant to this condition; 10) provide a DNA sample.

Count III: Gross Misdemeanor 3rd Degree Criminal Damage to Property: The defendant was given a \$3,000 fine and 365 days in jail with \$2,500 of the fine and 275 days in jail suspended for two years on the following conditions: 1) serve 90 day in the Washington County Jail with credit for 7 days served, time can be done on Work Release or in-custody Sentence to Service, concurrent with Count II; 2) pay a fine in the amount of \$500 plus surcharges, concurrent with Count II; 3) pay restitution in the amount of \$517 plus additional costs incurred if requested within 30 days of sentencing to the victim; 4) have no direct or in-direct contact with the victim, his residence, his family, or his place of employment; 5) complete an evaluation with a forensic psychologist and follow all recommendations for treatment plan, including taking all prescribed medication at the direction of the mental health professional; 6) abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random testing; 7) have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all standard conditions of probation; 8) have no weapons, no incendiary devices, or materials that can be used to make weapons; 9) submit his person, residence, office, computer, or vehicle to a random search, conducted by a probation officer or agent of the probation office.

In-custody Sentence to Service jail forthwith; 2) \$50 fine plus surcharges; 3) No contact with victim; 4) \$184.73 restitution to Washington County Emergency Relief Fund joint and several with co-defendant. 5) Restitution to victim in amount to be determined at hearing on 6-19-09 on co-defendant's case joint and several; 6) Restitution to State Farm in an amount to be determined at restitution hearing on 6-19-09 on co-defendant's case joint and several; 7) Cognitive skills evaluation and follow recommendations; 8) No same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with standard conditions of probation; 9) Pursuant to 609.117, defendant to provide a biological specimen for DNA analysis; and 10) Cooperate with transfer of probation.

Complete anger management evaluation and follow recommendations. 6. Abstain and submit to random testing. 7. Be law abiding. 8. Cooperate with transfer of probation. 9. Provide DNA sample.

SENTENCE: Count I - 5th Degree Possession: The defendant was given a stay of adjudication, pursuant to 152.18, and placed on probation for five years with the following conditions: 1) 23 days jail with credit for 3 days and it can be done on any alternative other than home monitor; 2) pay a \$300 fine plus surcharge; 3) complete a cognitive skills evaluation and follow the recommendations; 4) complete an out-patient chemical dependency treatment program and follow the aftercare recommendations; 5) abstain from the use of chemicals, including alcohol, submit to random testing; 6) attend MADD Impact Panel; 7) no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding; 8) meet with health care professional to consider treatment for depression.

Count II - 4th Degree DUI: The defendant was given a \$1,000 fine and 90 days jail. \$700 of the fine and 67 days of the jail time were suspended for two years with the same conditions as Count I. The fine, however, is in addition to Count I.

SENTENCE: Stay of imposition of sentence for five years on the following conditions: (1) supervised probation for five years; (2) serve 43 days in jail, with credit for 43 days served; (3) pay a \$50 fine and surcharges on a schedule to be determined by Court Administration; defendant may perform 10 hours of Community Work Service in lieu of the fines; defendant to pay restitution; (4) abstain from the use of mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalyses at his own expense; (5)

complete a chemical dependency evaluation and follow all the recommendations, including aftercare; (6) obtain a GED and provide written verification to the supervising probation agent; (7) have no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding, and cooperate with probation; (8) cooperate with the transfer of probation supervision to his county of residence, and (9) provide a biological specimen for DNA analysis.

SENTENCE: 17 months in prison, execution stayed for up to 10 years on the following conditions: (1) serve 180 days in jail, with credit for 35 days served; defendant may serve the balance of the jail sentence on work release or in-custody Sentence to Service (criteria waived); (2) pay a \$50 fine on a schedule to be determined by Court Administration; (3) abstain from the use of mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalyses at his own expense; (4) complete a chemical dependency evaluation while in jail, and follow all recommendations, including aftercare, and (5) have no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding, and cooperate with probation.

SENTENCE: Five-year stay of imposition of sentence on the following conditions: (1) serve 67 days in jail, with credit for 16 days served; defendant may serve the jail time on straight time, work release, or in or out-of-custody Sentence to Service (criteria waived); (2) pay a \$50 fine and surcharges on a schedule to be determined by Court Administration; (3) complete a Cognitive Skills Program evaluation and follow recommendations; (4) complete an anger management assessment and follow all recommendations; (5) abstain from the use of mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalyses at his own expense; (6) seek and maintain gainful employment or be enrolled full-time in school; (7) have no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding, and cooperate with probation, and (8) provide a biological specimen for DNA analysis.
