CONVICTION: Controlled Substance Crime 5th Degree
SENTENCE: Stay of adjudication, pursuant to 152.18, 5 years of probation on the following conditions: (1) Defendant to serve 4 days, credit for 4 days; (2) Defendant to abstain, including alcohol and submit to random testing, baseline today; (3) Defendant to seek and maintain gainful employment and provide verification; (4) Cognitive Skills Intake and follow recommendations; (5) Defendant to undergo mental health evaluation and follow recommendations; (6) No same/similar, be law abiding and cooperate with standard conditions of probation; (7) Defendant ordered not to possess any weapons while on probation; (8) \$50 fine, 180 days to pay.

SENTENCE: The defendant received the following sentence: Stay of imposition of sentence for up to three years on the following conditions: 1) supervised probation for up to three years; 2) serve 180 days in jail, with credit for 82 days served, defendant must begin serving a ten day sentence immediately, and the balance will be served on in-custody Sentence to Serve (criteria waived); 3) complete a psychological evaluation and follow all recommendations; 4) complete out-patient chemical dependency treatment, including any aftercare recommendations; 5) abstain from the use of mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis at his own expense; 6) prohibited from being inside any gambling establishment or participating in any forms of gambling; 7) have no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding, and cooperate with standard conditions of probation; 8) cooperate with the transfer of probation to his county of residence; 9) provide a biological specimen for DNA analysis; 10) pay a \$300 fine; 11) defendant to submit to the Intensive Probation Supervision Program, if he becomes a resident of Washington County.

SENTENCE: The Court sentenced the defendant to a stay of adjudication pursuant to 152.18 and placed the defendant on probation for 5 years under the following conditions: 1) Serve 3 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 3 days served. 2) Abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at his own expense. 3) Attend NA meetings at least twice per month for 12 months and provide written verification to the supervising probation officer. 4) Complete all mental health programming at the direction of the mental health professional. 5) No same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. 6) Pay a \$300 fine plus surcharges. The Judge ordered that if defendant completed a college degree he will be discharged from probation if no other violations.
