

**SENTENCING FOR

DEFENDANT: Daniel Wayne Willette

CONVICTION: Drugs - 5th Degree

SENTENCE: The defendant was committed to the Commissioner of Corrections for 13 months. Execution of sentence was stayed and the defendant was placed on probation for 10 years with the following conditions: 1) 180 days jail with credit back to October 19, 2009 and any other credit that he is owed for time spent in custody in Minnesota since the day of the offense; 2) \$250 fine; 3) restitution to Afton Alps in the amount of \$440.42, restitution to TCF Bank in Woodbury in the amount of \$3,680.50; 4) complete a chemical dependency evaluation and follow the recommendations; 5) provide a DNA sample.

Fourth Degree DUI: \$1,000 and 90 days, with \$800 and 90 days suspended for two years on the following conditions: (1) probation for two years; (2) pay a \$200 fine and surcharges; (3) abstain from alcohol and submit to random urinalyses; (4) remain law abiding and have no same or similar offenses; (5) seek and maintain gainful employment, and (6) attend a MADD Victim Impact Panel.

The execution of sentence is stayed and placed on probation for a period of 5 years under the following conditions: 1) serve 120 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 41 days served; time may be served on in-custody Sentence to Service and the criteria is waived; ordered to report to orientation for Sentence to Service within 30 days from discharge from the halfway house; 2) have no direct or indirect contact with the victim; 3) abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random testing at own expense; 4) complete residential chemical dependency treatment through Regions ADAP, including aftercare; 5) complete all mental health programming unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary; 6) seek and maintain gainful employment and/or education and provide verification to the supervising probation officer; 7) have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation; 8) pay a \$50 fine, plus surcharges.

Washington County Court Administration on a schedule to be established by the supervising probation officer; restitution is joint and several codefendant Michael Mason; 3) have no direct or indirect contact with the victim; 4) complete a chemical dependency evaluation within 30 days and follow all recommendations including aftercare plans; 5) abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random testing at own expense; 6) complete an evaluation for cognitive skills programming and follow all recommendations; 7) seek and maintain gainful employment or schooling and provide verification to the supervising probation officer; 8) have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation; 9) provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis; 10) pay \$50 fine, plus surcharges.
