SENTENCE: The defendant was given a \$3,000 fine and 365 days jail. \$3,000 of the fine and 358 days of the jail are suspended for two years with the following conditions: 1) 7 days jail with credit for 7 served; 2) no same or similar offenses and remain law abiding.

SENTENCE: Count I - Committed to the Commissioner of Corrections for 13 months, the court recommended a stay of execution of sentence and placed defendant on probation for 5 years under the following conditions: 1) Serve 30 days in jail with credit for 3 days. 2) Pay \$500 fine. 3) Pay restitution. 4) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. 5) Take all prescribed medications and submit to blood screening. 6) No same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. 7) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis. Count II - Committed to Commissioner of Corrections for 13 months under stay of execution and placed on probation for 5 years running concurrent with sentence in Count I. Conditions of probation are the same for both counts. Pay \$50 fine.

time to be served on the in-custody Sentence to Service Program during school breaks; (3) pay a fine in the amount of \$50 plus surcharges on a schedule to be established by Court Administration; (4) have no direct or indirect contact with the victim; (5) enter into and successfully complete a sex offender treatment program and follow all recommendations; (6) abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalyses at his own expense; (7) follow all standard conditions of the Sex Offender Unit, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary; (8) have no contact with minor females unless approved by the supervising agent; (9) submit to polygraph testing at the direction of his supervising probation agent; (10) have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation; (11) have no possession or use of a home computer unless approved by supervising agent and/or therapist; register as a predatory offender; provide a biological specimen for DNA purposes, and (14) cooperate with the transfer of his supervision to his county of residence.

SENTENCE: The court committed the defendant to the Commissioner of Corrections for 15 months and stayed the execution of the sentence and placed the defendant on probation for a period of three years under the following conditions: 1) serve 85 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 48 days served, and the time can be served under any in-custody alternative, if the defendant qualifies; 2) pay a \$100 fine plus surcharges; 3) pay restitution to the victim on a schedule to be established by the supervision probation officer; 4) have no direct or in-direct contact with the victims; 5) complete Anger Management and/or Domestic Abuse treatment program unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary; 6) complete a chemical dependency evaluation and follow all recommendations including after-care plans unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary; 7) abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at her own expense; 8) seek and maintain gainful employment and provide verification to the supervising probation officer; 9) have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation; 10) cooperate with the transfer of supervision to county/state of residence; 11) follow all standard conditions of the Intensive Supervision Unit if defendant is residing in Washington County, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary.
