DEFENDANT: Ryan Matthew Larson

AGENCY: St. Paul Park Police Department

CONVICTION: 4th Degree Controlled Substance - Sale Marijuana in a Park

SENTENCE: Imposition of sentence stayed and placed on probation for 10 years on following conditions: 1) serve 140 days in jail with credit for 5 days served, to be served on out-of-custody Sentence to Service 2) abstain from all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random testing at own expense; 3) comply with the recommendations set forth in the chemical dependency evaluation, including any treatment and aftercare; 4) seek and maintain gainful employment and/or education and provide verification; 5) complete a neuro-psychological evaluation and comply with all recommendations; 6) no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation; 7) provide a DNA sample per statute; 8) pay \$50 fine plus fees and surcharges.

SENTENCE: Imposition of sentence stayed and placed on probation for 10 years on following conditions: 1) serve 120 days in jail with credit for 1 day served, 1/2 of the time to be served on in-custody Sentence to Service, the other half on out-of-custody Sentence to Service, criteria waived; 2) no direct or indirect contact with the victim or victim's family; 3) no contact with female minors, under the age of 18 years old, until it has been determined to be appropriate by a therapist; 4) attend and complete sex offender treatment; 5) participate in and pay for any polygraph testing per the instructions of any treatment provider; 6) abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random testing at own expense; 7) follow all standard conditions of the Sex Offender Unit; 8) no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation; 9) cooperate with the transfer of supervision to county of residence; 10) register as a predatory offender; 11) provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis; 11) pay \$50 fine plus fees.

SENTENCE: On the 4th degree assault charge, Defendant was sentenced under a stay of imposition of sentence and placed on probation for a period not to exceed 3 years, subject to the following conditions: (1) Serve 20 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 6 days served. Time to be served on out-of-custody Sentence to Service; (2) Complete all mental health programming/including taking all prescribed medication; (3) Complete an evaluation for Cognitive Skills Programming; (4) Abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random testing at her own expense; (5) Seek and maintain gainful employment and provide verification; (6) Cooperate with the transfer of her probation to county of residence; (7) Have no same/similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all standard conditions of probation; (8) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis. On the DWI 3rd degree charge: 365 days in jail with 345 days suspended for two years on the following conditions: (1) Probation for 2 years; (2) 20 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 6 days served, time to be served on Electronic Home Monitoring or out-of-custody Sentence to Service; (3) Complete all mental health programming, including taking all prescribed medication; (4) Complete an evaluation for Cognitive Skills Programming; (5) Abstain from the use of mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at her own expense; (6) Seek and maintain gainful employment and provide verification; (7) Cooperate with the transfer of her supervision to her county of residence; (8) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation; (9) Fine \$100, surcharges waived. SENTENCE: Imposition of sentence stayed and placed on probation for 3 years on following conditions: 1) serve 39 days in jail with credit for 9 days served, to be served on out-of-custody Sentence to Service program; 2) no direct or indirect contact with the victims and any officer or administrator for the City of Bayport including Bayport Police Officers, unless it is within the performance of their duties as peace officers; 3) follow all recommendations of the June 3, 2009 psychological evaluation, including attend psychiatric evaluation scheduled 10/27, and follow all of those recommendations. Follow up with all recommendations for medication and counseling; 4) seek and maintain gainful employment and provide verification to the supervising probation officer; 5) complete a Cognitive Skills Programming evaluation and follow all recommendations; 6) complete the Resources for the Unemployed Determined Individual (RUDI) Program; 7) abstain from all mood altering substances, not including alcohol, and submit to random testing at own expense; 8) no same or similar offenses, no assault behavior, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation; 9) comply with rules and regulations of the Intensive Supervision Unit, unless deemed appropriate by the probation officer; 10) provide a DNA sample per statute; 11) pay \$50 fine plus fees.
