SENTENCE: The defendant was committed to the Commissioner of Corrections for a period of 15 months. Execution of sentence was stayed and the defendant was placed on probation for five years with the following conditions: 1) serve 45 days jail with credit for 30 days; 2) pay a fine of \$250 plus surcharges; 3) perform 300 hours of Community Work Service and provide verification to the supervising probation officer; 4) pay restitution; 5) have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all standard conditions of probation; 6) cooperate with the transfer of his supervision to county of residence.
