SENTENCE: Seven months in prison, execution stayed for up to 10 years on the following conditions: (1) Serve 180 days in jail, with credit for 54 days served; defendant may serve the jail time on in-custody Sentence to Service, and criteria were waived; (2) pay a \$200 fine and surcharges on a schedule to be determined by Court Administration; (3) complete a Cognitive Skills Programming evaluation and follow all recommendations; (4) complete all mental health programming, including taking all prescribed medication; (5) abide by the chemical dependency evaluation recommendations, including aftercare plans, (6) abstain from the use of mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalyses at his own expense, and (7) have no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding, and cooperate with probation.

Execution of sentence was stayed and the defendant was placed on probation for 7 years and is subject to the 5 year mandatory conditional release period, with the following conditions: 1) serve 180 days by serving 30 days on in-custody Sentence to Service, the next 30 days on Electronic Home Monitor and the remainder can be served on staggered sentencing of 60 days for each of the subsequent two years; 2) pay \$700 fine plus surcharge; 3) 30 days mandatory Electronic Home Alcohol Monitoring for one year; 4) Driving With Care Skills is ordered and he is to follow the recommendations; 5) abstain from mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, submit to random testing; 6) minimum of 30 hour relapse out-patient chemical dependency treatment program within 60 days; 7) attend AA meetings one time per week for 12 months; 8) attend MADD Impact Panel; 9) provide a DNA sample.
