CONVICTION: Predatory Offender Registration Violation
SENTENCE: The Court committed the defendant to the Commissioner of Corrections for a period of 16 months, with credit for time served of 193 days. Pursuant to §244.101, defendant shall serve 10 2/3 months in prison and 5 1/3 months on supervised release. If defendant commits any disciplinary acts the Commissioner may extend the amount of incarcerated time; fine of \$50.00.
