SENTENCE: The defendant was committed to the Commissioner of Corrections for 90 months under a stay of imposition and placed on probation for a period of 15 years subject to the following: 10 years conditional release, serve 180 days in the Washington County jail, predatory offender registration required, no contact with victim and her family, restitution will be left open for 6 months, complete sex offender treatment and follow aftercare, no contact with minors until approved by therapist, submit to polygraph testing, abstain from all mood altering chemicals including alcohol, be subject to random testing, remain law abiding and provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis.
