SENTENCE: Count I: Gross Misdemeanor Fleeing Police in a Motor Vehicle - the defendant was ordered to serve 1 year jail and pay a \$3,000 fine. 335 days of the jail time and \$2,700 of the fine were suspended for two years on the following conditions: 1) probation for 2 years; 2) serve the jail time, which can be done on out-of-custody Sentence to Service; 3) pay the fine; 4) complete all recommendations from the chemical dependency evaluation that was completed in Barron County; 5) abstain from the use of chemicals, including alcohol, submit to random testing; 6) no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding; 7) provide a DNA sample. Count II: 4th Degree DWI - the defendant was given 90 days jail and a \$1,000 fine. 60 days of the jail time and \$300 of the fine were suspended on the following conditions: 1) 2 years probation; 2) pay the fine which is in addition to Count I; 3) serve 30 days jail which is concurrent with Count I; 4) follow the recommendations of the chemical dependency evaluation; 5) abstain from the use of chemicals, including alcohol, submit to random testing; 6) attend a MADD Victim Impact Panel; 7) no same or similar offenses.

SENTENCE: On Count I: Theft of Motor Vehicle: The Court committed the defendant to the Commissioner of Corrections for 15 months and stayed the execution of sentence and placed the defendant on probation for 5 years under the following conditions: 1) Serve 113 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 81 days served. 2) Pay a fine of \$200 plus surcharges. 3) Pay restitution in the amount of \$745.88 to victims through Washington County Court Administration on a schedule to be established by the supervising probation officer. 4) Complete an evaluation for Cognitive Skills Programming and follow all recommendations. 5) Complete a chemical dependency evaluation within 10 days and follow all recommendations, including aftercare plans. 6) Abstain from the use of all mood altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at his own expense. 7) Attend a MADD Victim Impact

Panel. 8) Seek and maintain gainful employment and provide verification to the supervising probation officer. 9) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. 10) Cooperate with the transfer of his supervision to his county/state of residence. 11) Complete his high school equivalency unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 12) Complete a South Oaks Gambling Screen and follow any recommendations. 13) Pay restitution of \$20 to victim for the insurance co-pay and restitution is reserved for an additional 60 days so the victim can provide proof relating amount. The defendant has previously submitted a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis. On Count II: Misdemeanor DWI: The Court imposed a \$1,000 fine and 90 days in jail with \$500 suspended for 2 years and the defendant has credit for 81 days already served. The defendant is ordered to complete all the special probation conditions set forth for the Felony Theft of Motor Vehicle charge.
