

**SENTENCING FOR

DEFENDANT: Jennifer Lynn Rubio  
DOB: 5/16/1971  
CITY/RESIDENCE: Burnsville, MN  
AGENCY: Cottage Grove Police Department  
CONVICTION: Fifth Degree Controlled Substance Crime/Possession  
SENTENCE: Court stayed the adjudication of sentence pursuant to 152.18 and placed the defendant on probation for a period of five years under the following conditions: 1) serve 8 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 8 days served; 2) complete a chemical dependency evaluation and follow all recommendations, including aftercare plans; 3) abstain from the use of all mood altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random testing at own expense; 4) have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation; 5) cooperate with the transfer of her supervision to her county of residence; 6) pay a \$50 fine plus surcharges.

SENTENCE: The defendant was sentenced to 365 days and \$3,000 with 355 days and \$2,950 stayed for 2 years, placed on probation for a period of 2 years, required to complete the Program to Encourage Responsible Thinking, 10 days can be served on out-of-custody Sentence to Service and defendant required to remain law abiding.

If defendant does not report, he must serve 60 days straight time; 2) Have no direct or indirect contact with the victims, outside of workplace; 3) Abstain from the use of all mood altering chemicals including alcohol and submit to random testing; 4) Obtain a chemical dependency evaluation and follow recommendations; 5) Complete a psychological evaluation and follow all

recommendations and 6) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation.
