DEFENDANT: Annette Jean Meldaus

AGENCY: Woodbury Police Department
CONVICTION: Controlled Substance Crime in the Fifth Degree
SENTENCE: The defendant received a stay of adjudication and was placed on probation for five years with the following conditions: 1) 9 days jail with credit for 9 days served; 2) \$50 fine plus surcharge; 3) abstain from the use of chemicals, including alcohol, submit to random testing; 4) attend AA one time per week and provide verification; 5) obtain GED and provide verification; 6) no same or similar offenses and remain law abiding.

SENTENCE: The defendant was sentenced to 365 days jail and a \$3,000 fine. 364 days and \$2,800 of the fine were stayed and the defendant was placed on probation for two years with the following conditions: 1) complete a chemical dependency evaluation and follow the recommendations made; 2) remain law abiding.

Time can be served on Work Release, In-Custody Sentence to Service or Out-of-Custody Sentence to Service and criteria is waived. 2) Pay a fine of \$500 plus surcharges on a schedule to be established by Court Administration. 3) Have no direct or indirect contact with victims. 4) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation.

SENTENCE: Simple robbery: Court stayed the execution of sentence, placed the defendant on probation for up to ten years on the following conditions: (1) Serve 150 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 92 days; (2) Pay fine in the amount of \$50 plus surcharges; (3) Complete chemical dependency treatment, including aftercare; (4) Abstain and submit to random testing; (5) Attend AA/NA once per week for 12 months and provide verification; (6) Complete Cognitive Skills Programming and follow recommendations; (7) Have no same or similar offenses and be law abiding, cooperate with transfer of probation to county of residence.

Aiding and Abetting Theft-Motor Vehicle, the Court stayed the execution of sentence, placed the defendant on probation for a period of five years on the following conditions: (1) Serve 150 days in jail, 92 days of credit; (2) Impose the same conditions on this Count with the exception of waive of surcharges on fine.

The remaining time is to be served on out-of-custody Sentence to Service, with criteria waived or straight time, all of which can be done on the weekends. 2) The defendant was

ordered to pay a fine of \$3,000 with \$2,750 stayed, plus surcharges, on a schedule to be established by Court Administration. 3) Complete a domestic abuse evaluation and follow all recommendations. 4) Abstain from the use of all mood altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at his own expense, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 5) Seek and main gainful employment and provide verification to the supervising probation officer. 6) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. 7) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis.
