DEFENDANT: Jeneen Marie Peterson
DOB: 6/11/1960
CITY/RESIDENCE: St. Paul, MN
AGENCY: Oakdale Police Department
CONVICTION: Offering a Forged Check
SENTENCE: The defendant was committed to the Commissioner of Corrections for 1 year and 1 day. Execution of sentence was stayed and the defendant was placed on probation for five years with the following conditions: 1) 68 days jail with credit for 19 days, defendant is to do 9 days in custody, she can do it on weekends and the other 40 can be out-of-custody Sentence to Service; 2) restitution to Target Financial Services in the amount of \$249.56; 3) complete a cognitive skills evaluation and follow the recommendations; 4) no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding; 5) cooperate with the transfer of probation to county of residence; 6) provide a DNA sample; 7) pay a \$50 fine.

SENTENCE: The defendant was committed to the Commissioner of Corrections for 24 months with credit for 120 days served.

AGENCY: St. Paul Park Police Department
CONVICTION: Drugs Fifth Degree Possession
SENTENCE: Defendant committed to the Commissioner of Corrections for a period of 15 months; the Court stayed execution of sentence and placed defendant on probation for a period of five years under the following conditions: 1) Serve 92 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 92 days served; 2) Complete all mental health programming and chemical dependency programming including taking all prescribed medication at the direction of the mental health professional, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary; 3) Abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at his own expense, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary; 4) Attend AA meetings one time per week for six months and provide verification to the supervising probation officer; 5) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation; 6) Waive fine and 7) DNA sample.

SENTENCE: The Court stayed the imposition of sentence and placed the defendant on probation for a period of 5 years with the following conditions: 1) Serve 40 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 40 days served; 2) Complete an intake for Cognitive Skills Programming and follow all recommendations unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary; 3) Abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at his own expense, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary; 4) Have no weapon possession or reside in a home where weapons are located; 5) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions probation; 6) Cooperate with the transfer of his supervision to his county of residence; 7) Pursuant to §609.117, defendant ordered to provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis; and 8) \$100 plus surcharges/fees.
