SENTENCE: Execution of sentence was stayed and the defendant was placed on probation for 10 years with the following conditions: 1) serve 180 days jail with credit for 83 days, the balance can be done on work release or in- or out-of-custody Sentence to Service; 2) pay \$50 fine plus surcharge; 3) complete a cognitive skills evaluation and follow the recommendations; 4) abstain from mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, submit to random testing; 5) complete a chemical dependency evaluation and follow the recommendations; 6) seek and maintain gainful employment and provide verification; 7) no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding; 8) cooperate with the transfer of probation to county of residence; 9) provide DNA sample per statute.
