All persons or groups renting the Washington County Historic Courthouse for any event must have insurance to cover the event. You must provide the Washington County Historic Courthouse with proof of insurance two weeks (14 days) prior to the event.

Your event may not take place until proof of insurance is received.

- The insurance policy must be in the name of the person signing the lease agreement with the Historic Courthouse.
- We require Bodily Injury & Property Damage Liability with a minimum of \$500,000 per claimant and a minimum of \$1,500,000 single occurrence.
- Please list the Historic Courthouse as a "Certificate Holder" through the date of the event. Do NOT list the Historic Courthouse as "Additional Insured."

We recommend you contact your insurance agent to determine the amount of coverage you need to protect you and your assets. Acquiring appropriate insurance for your event protects you against claims and ensures you are covered in the event of an accident. New in 2010! Washington County now offers an insurance policy that can be purchased through the Historic Courthouse for events at the courthouse. The policy is offered through T. C. Field and Company and provides coverage in the amount of \$1,000,000 per claimant and \$2,000,000 per occurrence. The price of the policy is \$100 - \$200; depending on the type of event. Please talk to staff prior to your event if you wish to purchase this insurance.

NOTE: This insurance coverage is not automatic and you must sign and pay for the policy to activate coverage for your event.
