SENTENCE: The defendant was sentenced under a stay of imposition and placed on probation for a period of 5 years subject to the following conditions: 1) Serve 30 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 2 days served, may be with Electronic Home Monitoring; 2) Pay restitution in the amount of \$2,418.59 to the victim; 3) Have no direct or indirect contact with the victim; 4) Complete all mental health programming, including taking all prescribed medication; 5) Follow the recommendations of the Rule 82 Gambling Assessment; 6) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all standard conditions of probation; 7) Cooperate with the transfer of supervision to her county of residence and 8) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis.

Time to be served on Work Release or in-custody Sentence to Service; 2) pay restitution in the amount of \$500 to each victim, joint and several with any co-defendants; 3) have no direct or indirect contact with the victims; 4) complete a cognitive skills evaluation and follow all recommendations; 5) complete all mental health programming, including taking all prescribed medication at the direction of the mental health professional; 6) abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random testing at his own expense, provide a baseline urinalysis today; 7) have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all standard conditions of probation; 8) cooperate with the transfer of his supervision to county of residence; 9) provide a biological sample; 10) pay a \$50 fine.
