
Tax forms available at county libraries

For those who want to pick up tax forms – or take a look at them before taking them home or downloading them – an alternative to online sources is the Washington County Library branches. The county's libraries are the only locations at which copies of the forms may be obtained, outside of downloading them or purchasing them at office supply stores.

The forms are available free at the libraries.
