SENTENCE: The defendant was committed to the Commissioner of Corrections for 21 months. This time is to be concurrent to the time the defendant is presently serving and he is to receive credit for time served. The defendant was ordered to pay restitution to the victim. He is also to provide a DNA sample.
