DATE: 12/10/2009

DEFENDANT: Emily Elizabeth Ferguson

DOB: 11/24/1986

CITY/RESIDENCE: Hudson, WI

AGENCY: Washington County Sheriff's Office

CONVICTION: Flee Peace Officer

SENTENCE: Court stayed the imposition of sentence and placed the defendant on probation for 3 years and ordered defendant to pay a \$500 fine, serve 18 days in jail with credit for 18 days served, complete an updated chemical dependency evaluation within 30 days and follow all recommendations including aftercare; abstain from the use of all mood altering chemicals, including alcohol and submit to random testing, attend MADD VIP, have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with standard conditions of probation, cooperate with the transfer of supervision to county/state of residence, provide a biological specimen for DNA analysis.

SENTENCE: The defendant was given 90 days jail and a \$1000 fine. All jail time was suspended and \$700 of the fine was suspended with the conditions that the defendant have no same or similar offenses and remain law abiding.

SENTENCE: The Court stayed the adjudication of sentence and placed the defendant on probation under the supervision of Washington County Community Services for a period of up to 5 years. In addition to the standard conditions of probation, the follow recommendations are recommended: (1) Serve 3 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 3 days served; (2) Abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers; (3) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation; (4) Ordered to cooperate with the transfer of her supervision to her County/State of residence; (5) \$100 fine, plus surcharges.

SENTENCE: Defendant committed to the Commissioner of Corrections for 23 months, restitution to be left open for 60 days, \$50 fine, surcharges waived; restitution and fine to be deducted from prison wages.

CONVICTION: 1st Degree DWI/DUI

SENTENCE: Committed to the Commissioner of Corrections for 48 months and stayed the execution of the sentence and placed on probation for a period of 7 years under the following conditions: 1) serve 365 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 181 days served; 30 days to be served now, and the remainder of the time will be done through staggered sentencing. The balance of the jail time will be addressed at a review hearing; 2) ordered to successfully complete the Salvation Army 5 level Residential Program and complete aftercare requirements. 3) have no same or similar offenses, no chemical violations, no consumption of alcohol or non-prescribed mood-altering chemicals 4) follow the standard conditions of probation. 5) pay a \$50 fine plus surcharges.

CONVICTION: Malicious Punishment of Child, 3rd Degree Assault - Victim Under 4

SENTENCE: On the Malicious Punishment of Child charge: Stay of Imposition of sentence for up to five years on the following conditions: 1) supervised probation for up to five years; 2)

serve 120 days in jail, with credit for 85 days served; although the defendant has completed his jail sentence, the court authorized future jail to be in or out-of-custody Sentence to Service, with criteria waived; 3) complete an anger management program and schedule a program intake with Lake Area Human Services within 30 days and follow all recommendations; 4) complete mental health programming, including taking all prescribed medication; 5) abstain from the use of mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis at own expense; 6) attend AA/NA meeting three times per week for one year and provide verification to the supervising probation agent; 7) complete the RUDI (Resources for the Unemployed and Determined Individual) employment program; 8) seek and maintain gainful employment and provide verification to the supervising probation agent; 9) have no indirect or direct contact with the victims, unless contact is authorized by the family court and the Child in Need of Protective Services case; 10) follow all standard conditions of the intensive probation supervision program; 11) have no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding, and cooperate with probation; 12) provide a biological specimen for DNA analysis, and 13) pay a \$50 fine.

On the 3rd Degree Assault charge the defendant received the same conditions as the above-mentioned Malicious Punishment of Child charge.

SENTENCE: On the 5th Degree Drugs charge, the defendant received the following felony sentence: a stay of adjudication for up to 5 years on the following conditions: 1) supervised probation for up to five years; 2) serve four days in jail, with credit for four days served; 3) complete a cognitive skills programming evaluation and follow all recommendations; 4) complete all mental health programming, including counseling and/or a pain clinic, and take all prescribed medications; 5) notify Community Corrections of all doctors prescribing medications, and permitting the doctor's to notify any other physician of the defendant's chemical health history; 6) cooperate with doctor's and probation's recommendations regarding alternative treatment, including pain clinic, regarding the discontinued use of opiates and muscle relaxers; 7) abstain from the use of mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis at own expense; 8) attend AA/NA meetings twice per week while on probation; 9) have no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding, and cooperate with probation, and 10) pay \$50 fine (surcharges were waived).

On Count II (3rd Degree. DWI) the defendant received the following GM sentence: 365 days in jail, and a \$3000 fine with 361 days and \$2500 suspended for up to three years on the same conditions as the felony sentence for 5th Degree Drugs, plus pay a \$500 fine.
