SENTENCE: The defendant was committed to the Commissioner of Corrections for 13 months.
Execution of sentence was stayed and the defendant was placed on probation for five years with the following conditions: 1) serve 60 days jail with credit for 3 days, can be done on in-custody Sentence to Service or home detention; 2) complete a cognitive skills evaluation and follow the recommendations; 3) abstain from the use of chemicals, including alcohol, submit to random testing; 4) no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding; 5) no contact with CVS Pharmacy and Walgreens in Woodbury; 6) provide a DNA sample; 7) cooperate with transfer of probation.
